SHOW RULES

1. **ENTRY FEES** See individual entry forms for proper fees. All fees are per class, per animal. There will be no payback. All rabbits entered in fur must also be entered in its own breed class. **There will be a \$35.00 service charge added to any check returned not paid by the bank.**
2. Entries must be **postmarked** no later than **Saturday, April 10, 2010**. Entry fee **MUST** accompany entry.
3. Entries for the **Southern Colorado single open and youth shows** are “**day of show**”. Rabbits must be entered by 9:00 a.m.
4. This is an ARBA SANCTIONED SHOW. By the filing of your entry you indicate your acceptance of all our show rules and the rules of the ARBA which govern this show (Sec. 45 - 56 exhibitor rules of ARBA). **THE SHOW COMMITTEE RESERVES THE RIGHT TO REMOVE ANY PERSON OR PERSONS CAUSING ANY PROBLEM.**
5. All animals showing signs of disease shall be removed from the showroom (sec. 31 show sponsor rules of ARBA.)
6. **ARBA Rule. SECTION 52. Youth exhibitors may enter sanctioned youth shows between the ages of five (5) and eighteen (18) years. An adult cannot show in youth classes at any time. Youth exhibitors must be able to handle their own animals. If stated in the show catalog, all youth entries must be carried by youth. Youth exhibitors are not required to carry their own animals to the table. Youth may not enter the same rabbit in both open and youth shows at the same show. Youth may enter in both open and youth shows with different rabbits.**
7. Judging will begin at **8:00 AM-SHARP!!!**
8. **SUBSTITUTIONS** will be allowed in the **SAME BREED, CLASS, VARIETY AND SEX AT CHECK IN. NO OUT OF CLASS SUBSTITUTIONS.** **All breed show: substitutions will be taken at the time of judging.**
9. Club requires an email address or contact number for entry clarification. Show reports will be sent via email to all exhibitors not receiving a leg of grand champion.
10. This is a coop show. Coops will be provided for all rabbits entered in the shows. Coops for sale rabbits not entered in the show will require a fee of \$2.00. Scholarship auction rabbits excluded.
11. Any coops locked or fastened are the responsibility of the exhibitor or delegate. Every effort will be made by the sponsoring club to make sure rabbits get to the table.
12. All stock **MUST** have a **PERMANENT, LEGIBLE EAR MARK** in the **LEFT EAR**, or they will be eliminated.
13. All rights reserved to substitute judges in any event. Superintendent(s) reserves the right to make any changes he/she deems necessary. National shows will start first; other shows will begin as judges become available. No one is allowed in the judging area except for show officials and assistants.
14. **PLEASE KEEP YOUR AREA CLEAN. NO SMOKING IN THE BUILDING. NO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES ALLOWED DURING SHOWS. PLEASE KEEP TRACK OF YOUR CHILDREN.**
15. The Show Committee, or the owner, agent, or management of the show facility, or any other related organization will **NOT BE HELD RESPONSIBLE** for any type of theft, accident, or personal injury to any person or personal property, (whether owned, borrowed, or rented,) due to neglect, or any other cause.
16. **NO DOGS ALLOWED IN THE SHOWROOM OTHER THAN SERVICE DOGS.**
17. **NO animals under six (6) weeks will be allowed on the premises or in the showroom of any RMHS sanctioned show for any purpose.**

Directions to The Colorado State Fair

Traveling from the North: Take I-25 South to Exit 97A (Central Avenue Exit). Go north one block to Northern Avenue. Turn left on Northern Avenue to Prairie Avenue. Turn right on Prairie Avenue and go two blocks to fairgrounds.

Traveling from the South: Take I-25 North to Exit 97A (Central Avenue Exit). Go north one block to Northern Avenue. Turn left on Northern Avenue to Prairie Avenue. Turn right on Prairie Avenue and go two blocks to fairgrounds.

Traveling from the West: Take Highway 50 East to Pueblo Boulevard. Turn right on Pueblo Boulevard to Thatcher Avenue. Turn left on Thatcher Avenue to Prairie Avenue. Turn right on Prairie Avenue and go four blocks to fairgrounds.

Traveling from the East: Take Highway 50 West to 4th Street. On 4th Street go west. Be aware that 4th Street becomes Lincoln Street then becomes Thatcher Avenue. Stay on Thatcher Avenue to Prairie Avenue. Turn left on Prairie Avenue and go four blocks to fairgrounds.
