
Chinchilla Britannia Petite



Chinchilla-The surface color is to be a sparkling blend of black and pearl. The undercolor is to be a slate blue. Intermediate band is to be pearl to off white with the top edge being a very narrow black band, above this a very light band, brightly ticked with jet black hairs. Ticking may be more even due to the shorter fur desired in the breed. Neck fur is lighter in color than the body, but strictly confined to the nape. Chest is to be lightly ticked with a uniform shade of pearl, slightly lighter than the body. The body color is to extend as far down the sides as possible. Belly color, next to skin, may be white or blue with surface

color being white. Eye circles are to be well defined, narrow, and light pearl in color. Ears are to be laced with black. Under side of the tail is to be white, with the top of the tail black interspersed with white hairs.

Eyes-Brown, blue-gray or marbled.

Faults—Fault animals that are too light or too dark in surface color. Brown patches or brownish intermediary bands are undesirable.
