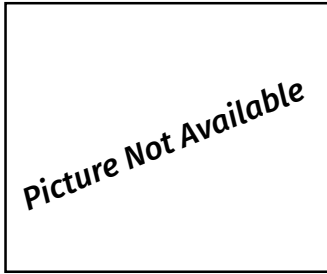


Fawn Rex



Fawn—The surface color of the body is to be a cream straw color, carried uniformly over the body, head, outside of the ears, front forelegs and top of the tail. Color should extend well down the hair shaft to a slightly lighter undercolor. The chest, belly, eye circles, nostrils, jowls, and underside of the tail should be a slightly lighter shade of cream. Do not fault for a light blue or lilac ticking on the surface color and ear lacing. Toenails should show pigment. Eyes – Blue-gray
