

## RABBIT JUDGE REVIEW TEST

- 1) You are placing a class and discover that a rabbit's ear number does not match the control sheet. You consult the show secretary and discover that the ear number also does not match the entry form. What do you do?
  - a. *Dismiss the rabbit from the class* [ARBA Show Rules Section 26 (D)]
  - b. Disqualify the rabbit
  - c. Place the rabbit anyway
  - d. Ask the writer to change the ear number
  
- 2) A judge is required to make placements on all animals in a class of \_\_\_ or fewer. (20) [ARBA Show Rules Section 68]

- 4) Exhibitors may not show under a judge who is an immediate family member. Immediate family member is defined as:
