

Giant Angora Chocolate Agouti



CHOCOLATE AGOUTI—Surface color is to be rich chocolate, ticked with chocolate tipped guard hairs. It shall have one or more bands of tan, alternating with dove-gray, with a dove-gray undercolor. The chest and belly are to be light tan to cream with dove-gray undercolor preferred. Eye circles, nostrils, jowls, and underside of the tail are to be light tan to cream. Ears are to be laced in chocolate and toenails should show pigment. Eyes – Brown, ruby cast permissible.

Faults—Poor ring definition

Disqualification from Competition—Complete lack of banding.
