

Howard Gwin Scholarship Award - for graduating Seniors only

Application

1. Follow deadlines.
 - Must be received (not postmarked) by the deadline.
 - Submit Early to avoid unforeseen circumstances.
2. Follow instructions provided.
3. Be neat and complete.
 - A typed application is required.
 - Use correct grammar, spelling, and punctuation. Double check, spell check.
 - Complete all questions. Do not leave any blank or NA.
4. Final Touches
 - Proofread.
 - Keep a copy of the application you submit.
5. Content
 - Be specific and detailed about past achievements (including dates).
 - The readers want to get to know you and your experience – Be descriptive.
 - Be organized in your responses.

Interview

6. Be prepared to answer these types of questions:
 - Your personal and character strengths
 - Proudest accomplishments/achievements
 - Tell me about yourself.
 - Influences in your life
 - Your personal and career goals
7. Be on time – call in for the teleconference interview at the designated time.
8. Speak clearly and concisely.
9. Be polite – Thank interviewers for their time.

Application Requirements:

- 1) The attached application form must be typed and emailed to cfries4330@aol.com by June 15,2024.
- 2) Proof of official acceptance in a college or trade school must be submitted with the completed application form.
- 3) The applicant may have to participate in a telephone interview.

Applications received after June 15, 2024, will not be accepted. A confirmation email will be sent.

The award shall be sent to the student, or the parent/guardian following graduation in the same year the scholarship is awarded. The applicant needs to be an ARBA member in district 9.

- Two (2) scholarships of \$500.00 each can be awarded each year, one each, for an ARBA member that will be enrolled in a college or trade school.
- The check will be made payable to the recipient after proof of enrollment or tuition payment in a college or trade school is provided.
- This is a one-time scholarship.
- Checks will be mailed in mid to late August.

1. Be an active member ARBA district 9.
2. Be accepted into a school of higher education, or a trade school.

Applications must be received by June 15, 2024. Materials that need to be submitted include:
