Color—(Black, Blue, Chocolate, Lilac) - The entire body is to be a pure clean white, except for nose, ears, feet and tail, which are to be colored (eye stain permissible)

Disqualifications from Competition—Any color or smut on any usable portion of the pelt (dewlap excluded) Absence of color on nose, ears, feet or tail. Definite clean white spot in colored markings. Do not disqualify for molting, frosting, or dilution, which may make the point color appear faded and less distinct.
