Central States Nomads Show Policy

This listing of show policy is intended to provide Central States Nomads show policy in general. All specific information will be provided on the event page by the host of the event page. Should the event page and this policy be in conflict, the event page has precedence.

ENTRY INFORMATION

PLEASE DO NOT send your entries via Facebook message, text, or by post/comment on the Facebook page. Please make sure to include each exhibitor's name, address, and phone number. Please also state clearly which shows you want each rabbit/cavy entered in. Include Ear Number, Breed, Variety, Class and Sex. Before calling the secretary, please check your spam folder.

(PLEASE NO ATTACHMENTS)

Email entries for Friday and Saturday Open and Youth All-breed shows and specialty shows to the address listed on the event page.

BE SURE THAT YOU RECEIVE AN EMAIL CONFIRMATION WITHIN 24 HOURS OF SUBMITTING YOUR ENTRY (within 3 days of deadline). If you don't receive one, your entry may not have been received. After checking your Spam folder, please check in with the secretary.

Entry fees may be paid by cash or check at the time of check in. If you want to pre-pay we accept entries via PayPal at **bobdonnell197021@yahoo.com**. We do not accept credit cards.

CHECK IN AND SHOW TIMES (All times are local times to the show venue)

- All Friday Shows – Start at 6:30 pm
- Friday Check in for All Shows – 3:00 pm – 6:00 pm
- Saturday all-breed shows start at 8:00 am
- Saturday Check in from 6:00 am – 7:30 am
- Building opens at 6:00 AM on Saturday
- Rabbits may be left in the Building overnight on Friday night, but MUST be removed on Saturday when BIS is completed.

All-Breed Best In Show Judging:

Best in show rabbits will be chosen at the end of the day after the completion of all shows. If you cannot stay for the conclusion of the last show, please arrange to leave your BOB animals with a friend for the BIS competitions.

SHOW RULES

1. This show will be governed by the latest [ARBA Show Rules](#). Filing of entries indicates acceptance of our show rules. Exhibitors are responsible for checking entries for errors and making changes BEFORE judging begins. Entry fees must be paid in full.
2. Exhibitors are responsible for all exhibitor fees. Should you enter and not attend, you will be billed for your entry fees. Your mail or email entry is a contract and fees are payable regardless of your attendance. Exhibitors that do not come to the show will be sent a bill and will not be allowed to enter animals in future Rabbit Renegade or Central States Nomad Shows until the bill is paid. Exceptions may be made in the case of emergency or unforeseen illness, as long as the show is notified prior to the show.
3. Entry fees are \$4 per rabbit per show and \$2 per fur per show unless otherwise posted on the Facebook Event page. If you enter only one show, fees are \$5 per rabbit for the single show. We will accept day of show entries from those who have already entered at \$6 per rabbit per show.
4. The Show Staff has the right to refuse entries from any exhibitor for due cause.

5. Neither the Central States Nomads or the venue will be responsible for loss in case of fire, theft or accident. All precautions will be taken for a safe show. All entries are entered and shown at the risk of the owners and while the Central States Nomads are expected to exercise all reasonable care in the handling and protection of the exhibits, such associations will in no case be liable.
6. Central States Nomads reserves the right to add, change, or substitute judges as the need may arise.
7. Any exhibitor indicating ownership, harassing, or interfering with a judge (or a writer) will be disqualified and forfeit all fees and winnings. No exhibitor will be allowed behind the judging tables, unless acting in an official capacity, which must be approved by the show superintendent or show secretary. Any disrespect, arguing or harassment of show staff or other exhibitors will not be tolerated and will lead to the offending parties entry being forfeited and the offending party will be required to leave the venue and will give up any rights to refunds, show reports, and awards and potential exclusion from future events.
8. Friday shows will start promptly at 6:30 p.m. local time. Saturday shows start at 8:00 a.m. Please be on time.
9. Rabbits must be in leakproof carriers/cages.
10. Show management are compelled to refuse entry to show room and to remove from the same, all diseased or unsightly animals. All entry fees on such animals shall be forfeited.
11. This is a no comment card show – we will be using control sheets only at the judges table.
12. No dogs are allowed in the showroom without permission; Working Service Dogs will be admitted. If you see an animal in the building, other than rabbits or cavies, it's best to speak with the superintendent or secretary first.

13. NO CHANGES MAY BE MADE AT THE JUDGING TABLES other than those approved by the show secretary. Unapproved changes may result in your animal being disqualified by the secretary after the show. Once a show starts, no changes will be made to the paperwork. ARBA Show Rules, Section 23 ... “No substitutions, changes, or additions will be allowed in a breed after judging of the breed has commenced.”

14. No sales of any rabbits or caviars will be allowed by anyone not showing rabbits or caviars. Any exhibitor wishing to sell anything other than rabbits or caviars must pay a vendor fee and must receive permission BEFORE the show. No product pre-sales or pre-orders or deliveries may be made at the show site without permission - in the building or on the grounds.

NO DOGS ALLOWED

– Working Service Dogs will be admitted – Service Dogs in Training will NOT be admitted
Rabbit Renegades/Central States Nomad asks that any Service Animal that is brought to an event meet ADA requirements. We strictly enforce a leash law and ask that any service dog that is brought to the facility be kept on their leash and under control of the owner at all time, according to ADA requirements. https://www.ada.gov/service_animals_2010.htm
