REGISTRAR

A licensed ARBA Rabbit Registrar will be available at the show. Registration is optional and is separate from show entry. During the registration process, each rabbit will be examined for disqualifications, weighed, and the required paperwork will be completed for submission into ARBA's official database. Registration is required in order to obtain any Grand Champion certificates from ARBA.

Exhibitors must provide:

1. ARBA membership card
2. a pedigree (printed copy preferred)
3. registration fee of \$6.00 for each rabbit presented


To be eligible, rabbits must be at least six months of age, meet senior weight and breed requirements, and be free from disqualifications. For further information, exhibitors should consult the registrar at the show.

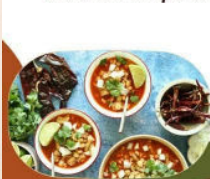

SHOW RULES

ARBA RULES & LIABILITY

This show will be conducted in full accordance with the most current Official Show Rules of the ARBA. Submitting an entry constitutes acceptance of both ARBA and Blackland Prairie RBA show rules. Each person in attendance assumes all risks and liabilities individually. Neither the Maude Cobb Convention Center, ARBA, Blackland Prairie RBA, nor the show committee and its members will be responsible for any accident, illness, death, injury, damage, or harm to exhibitors or their animals arising from participation in this event. Every reasonable precaution will be taken to ensure a safe show.

HEALTH

Animals showing any signs of illness or disease **will not** be admitted to the showroom. Show management is required to refuse entry, or remove from the premises, any animal that is diseased or unsightly. **Any rabbit showing signs of a potentially contagious disease will be ineligible to compete in any further shows. Table writers will complete a slip for these rabbits, which will be sent back to the secretary with the show paperwork to ensure the rabbit is scratched from all subsequent shows.** Entry fees for such animals will be forfeited.


All animals must be healthy and transported in proper, leak-proof carriers to ensure their safety and well-being. No coops will be provided. Does with litters are not permitted on the show grounds.

As of the date of this catalog, Texas does not require health certificates for entry. However, exhibitors are responsible for checking and complying with the most current regulations regarding rabbit transport before departure.

ANIMALS Only rabbits, cavies, and certified working service animals are permitted inside the building. Any service animal that becomes disruptive may be required to leave.

IDENTIFICATION All entries must have a permanent, legible ear identification in the left ear. Animals lacking proper identification will be disqualified, and entry fees will be forfeited.

SALES & FUNDRAISERS No club, organization, or individual may solicit subscriptions, donations, drawings, or distribute/display information in or around the showroom without prior approval from Blackland Prairie RBA. Exhibitors wishing to sell anything other than animals must obtain permission in advance and pay the required vendor fee. Product pre-sales, pre-orders, or deliveries at the show site are not permitted without prior authorization.





SHOW RULES

Youth Exhibitors The same animal may not be entered in both the Youth and Open shows at the same event. An animal may be shown in either the Youth Show **or** the Open Show, but not in both. Anyone, regardless of age, may exhibit in an Open Show. Youth Shows are limited to exhibitors between the ages of 5 and 18. Exhibitors who are 4 years old and younger or 19 years old and older must compete in the Open Show.

Conduct

All decisions of the judges are final. Exhibitors are expected to conduct themselves in a professional and respectful manner toward judges, show officials, writers, and fellow exhibitors. This expectation applies to both adults and youth. Any exhibitor who identifies ownership of an animal during judging, harasses, or interferes with a judge or writer will be disqualified and forfeit all fees and winnings. Behavior deemed disruptive or detrimental to the show or its participants will not be tolerated. Only show officials, judges, and designated writers are permitted in the judging area.


Parents are responsible for the conduct and actions of their children. Any damages caused by children will be the financial responsibility of the parent for repair or replacement. For safety reasons, skateboards, roller skates, rollerblades, scooters, and similar items are not permitted inside the building.

Judging

Owners are responsible for getting their rabbits to the show table. In Youth Shows, rabbits must be carried by the youth exhibitor (ages 5–18); adults are not permitted to place rabbits on or off the show table for youth exhibitors. Exhibitors are responsible for ensuring their animals are in the judging area when called, though they are not required to carry them personally. No entry fees will be refunded under any circumstances. Three calls will be made from the judging table; after the third call, only the rabbits present will be judged. Judging for a second show may begin before the first show is completed, so exhibitors must pay close attention to calls for their breed to avoid being passed over. All awards must be picked up on the day of the show. Exhibitor reports and legs will be emailed within 30 days following the conclusion of the show. Please provide a legible and valid email address when entering.

Exceptions

Any issue arising that cannot be resolved by reference to the above will be referred to the official show committee and their decision will be final. Complaints regarding exhibitors or judges will be accommodated with an official ARBA complaint form.

Tips & FAQ

This is a carrying cage show—your rabbits stay in their carriers until called to the table for judging.

The building has A/C. If it's chilly outside, the building will not be heated for human comfort, so dress in layers. Please bring your own chairs and rabbit supplies.

Be sure to read the catalog at least **THREE** times, and review the [ARBA Show Rules](#).

We'll use white boards and a speaker system to announce breeds as they go up for judging. It's your responsibility to keep up and get your rabbits to the table. A good tip—find someone showing the same breed and follow their lead. If you show multiple breeds, ask friends to help cover one so you don't miss anything.

If this is your first ARBA show, have an experienced breeder check your rabbit's breed, variety, and sex before the show begins. Once judging starts, changes can't be made without slowing everyone down.

And remember, everyone working the show is a volunteer. Mistakes happen, but kindness and flexibility go a long way. At the end of the day, we're all here because we love showing, talking about, and enjoying rabbits with friends!
