
HARE RAISERS 4-H CLUB

Our ARBA youth show is held in conjunction with the Baltimore & Howard Co. RCBA show, with the youth show <u>running first</u> starting at 9 AM, potentially on all 8-10 tables.

The open shows immediately follow youth judging.

Do bring help if you are showing more than one breed.

Adults may help as long as the youth owner is present and showing on another table.

Adult owned or co-owned rabbits may not show in youth.

Best in Show Youth is judged in the morning when all the youth breeds are done.

See the Baltimore & Howard Co. RCBA show catalog for complete information on the youth show. Online entry is handled through Easy2Show by searching for Hare Raisers. Please arrive by 8 am so you are settled and ready for your show.

Since these are 2 different clubs, youth rabbits may be shown in open, and we encourage youth to enter the Hare Raisers show and at least Open Show A to find out how well your rabbits place in open.

Sometimes the youth rabbits are better than the adult owned rabbits!
