SHOW RULES

All official ARBA rules as of the date of each show will be in effect for these shows.

1. Judging will begin at the time listed at the top of the catalog. Breeds will be called a max of 3 times. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to make sure their rabbits make it to the table.
2. Youth entries must be put on the table by a youth exhibitor unless the host club announced otherwise prior to the show.
3. All animals shown must be permanently and legibly tattooed.
4. The show superintendent may remove any animal showing signs of illness.
5. There will be no changes to the show paperwork made at the judges table unless authorized by the show secretary. If an exhibitor is caught making an unauthorized change, the exhibitor's entry will be disqualified.
6. No refunds will be provided for scratched entries. If you enter a rabbit and decide not to come, barring any major health or weather issues, you are still responsible for paying your fees via PayPal. Failure to pay fees will result in suspending all entries moving forward until balances are paid.
7. No animals other than rabbits and service animals will be allowed in the showroom. No dogs in training will be allowed.
8. IRBA is not responsible for any loss due to fire, theft, etc. All reasonable precautions will be taken to prevent any of these from occurring.

9. Children are the responsibility of their parents - no screaming or running in the showroom. Parents will be held responsible for any damages that may occur.
10. IRBA reserves the right to add, cancel, or substitute judges at any time.
11. All ARBA RHDV2 rules apply.
