FAQ

Q: DO I HAVE TO BE AN ARBA MEMBER TO ENTER?

A: Nope! You can enter without being a member of any organization. However, it is encouraged that you join the ARBA as there are many benefits to being a member.

Q: DO I NEED TO SEND MY ENTRY IN MULTIPLE EMAILS?

A: Please do not send multiple emails for one exhibitor. Even if you are adding to your entry before it is processed, DO NOT send a completely new email. Just reply to the original one. If you are sending for multiple exhibitors, it is preferred to have each exhibitor be sent separate.

Q: HOW DO I PAY MY ENTRY FEES? I WANT TO VENMO MY FEES BUT I DON'T SEE A VENMO ADDRESS.

A: If a payment method was an option, it would be readily listed - Venmo, PayPal, etc are NOT accepted by Wanderlust Rabbit & Cavy Shows. We accept Cash when you arrive at the show OR Checks made out to WRCS.

Q: MY BREED ISN'T SANCTIONED! CAN I ENTER?

A: Yes! You may enter any ARBA recognized breed or exhibition breed with an active COD in the Wanderlust RCS All-Breed shows. You may only enter Specialty Shows if there is a specialty for your breed (Rare Breed shows accept multiple breeds, list can be found at arba.net)

Q: CAN I ENTER DAY OF SHOW?

A: No Day of Show Entries will be accepted. Last chance for email entries will be 11:59PM PDT Friday April 04, 2025. No additional entries will be accepted after unless the show committee extends the deadline.

Q: CAN I COME AND SEE THE SHOW AS A SPECTATOR?

A: Yes, anyone is welcome to be a spectator. However you must not interfere with judging and it is very important to be mindful of the exhibitors, animals, and officials that are participating.

Q: MY BREED IS ALWAYS CALLED A "FUR BREED", SO THAT MEANS I HAVE TO ENTER THE FUR CLASS RIGHT?

A: Any and all rabbit breeds may compete in a fur class. It is not required for any breed. If you have a fur breed, you will receive fur comments in the regular judging class. Fur class is just that animal is judges solely on its coat quality. Animals MUST be entered in the regular class in order to compete in fur.

Q: MY RABBIT IS BLOWING COAT AND I DON'T WANT TO BRING THEM. DO I HAVE TO PAY FOR THE RABBIT?

A: Yes. We do not allow omissions to entries once the email entry deadline printed in the official catalog has passed. You may substitute with any other rabbit as long as its the same breed up until the change deadline. Even in the event that an entry deadline extension is granted, no omissions will be allowed. If you have any scratches, please make them known at check-in if at all possible.

2. Animals are entered at the sole risk of owners. WRCS will not be responsible for accidents, loss, or damage which may occur to the exhibitors or stock.
3. All rabbits must be permanently marked in the left ear prior to showing. The show registrar will only be responsible for tattooing rabbits being registered. Supplemental tattoos will be at the discretion of the registrar.
4. CHILDREN MUST BE SUPERVISED BY AN ADULT AT ALL TIMES!
5. Exhibitors are responsible to make sure their rabbits are taken to the judging area when called. Absolutely no refund of entry fees will be made.
6. Awards must be picked up the day of the show. Legs will be mailed within 30 days of the show.
7. Any WRCS show within the weekend whose entries total up to less than 15 entries will be subject to cancellation.
8. All animals must be healthy and in proper-size transport cages to ensure rabbits' well-being. Any animal showing signs of disease or illness or disqualified for disease or illness must be removed from the showroom and subsequent entries scratched. WITHOUT EXCEPTION!
9. The club and/or its officers are not liable for any injury or damage in connection with the show.
10. No dogs allowed except legitimate service animals as provided by all state and federal laws.
11. Exhibitors must clean their area when leaving; otherwise a fine may be imposed.
12. Any issue arising that cannot be resolved by reference to the above rules shall be decided by the official show committee, whose decision will be final.
13. Once entry is made the Entry Fee is Due! Even if you are unable to attend, the funds need to be paid. Failure to pay the fees will result in you being banned from WRCS shows until balance is paid. Late fees may be applied to your balance if an extended period of time passes.
