Per current State of Tennessee regulations, health certificates are <u>NOT REQUIRED</u> unless the rabbit is entering from a state which has had a confirmed case of RHVD2 in the <u>past 8 months</u>.

If coming from a state with a confirmed case, the CVI (health certificate) is required and must have been issued within 72 hours of show date

Showroom will open at 6:30 AM Central time; judging will start promptly at 8:30 AM

Early check-in and setup times for exhibitors will be available on Friday evening. This location is a covered, open pavilion without any way to secure the contents within it. Anything left overnight is at the discretion of the exhibitor.

Any breeds showing 10 or more at this show will be automatically sanctioned at the next show.

Day of show entries: Saturday April 12th, 2025 from 7:00-7:30am Central time - \$6.00 each per show ANY CHANGES ON DAY OF SHOW WILL BE \$1.00 EACH; MUST BE COMPLETED BY 7:30AM – NO EXCEPTIONS THERE WILL BE NO REFUNDS ON ANY ENTRIES SUBMITTED PREVIOUS TO DAY OF SHOW THEN SCRATCHED

When sending entries via eMail please include the following in addition to the information on the rabbits:

The shows entering (Youth - Show A, B and or Open C; Open - Show A, B and or C), exhibitor's name, complete mailing address and telephone number (with area code). You will receive a confirmation from the Show Secretary confirming that the entries were received and have been recorded. This communication should be made with you no later than the Thursday before the show at 12:00pm. If you do not receive a confirmation by then please contact the Show Secretary ASAP to confirm your entries were received. Please review all information on the check in sheets sent to confirm accuracy and if there is any errors contact the Show Secretary.

Entry fees may be paid on Friday evening during early check in or Saturday morning from 6:30-7:30am.

ALL EXHIBITORS MUST BE CHECKED IN, ENTRIES VERIFIED AND ANY CHANGES MADE BY 7:30AM SATURDAY

Payment must be either by CASH or CHECK only

NO debit/credit cards or electronic payments (PayPal, Venmo, etc.) are accepted

If paying by cash the exact amount owed is appreciated but not required, if paying by check it can <u>only</u> be accepted if written for the exact amount owed for entries. Please make all checks payable to LCRBA.

Attention all exhibitors, please read the following completely. If you are not going to be able to attend for any reason after sending your entries, please contact the Show Secretary ASAP by PHONE ONLY (NO EMAIL) so we can plan accordingly. Any reasonable reasons for not being able to attend will be accepted without judgement, we understand that life happens. Our policy is a simple three strike rule, that is should you (#1) pre-enter, (#2) not attend and (#3) not contact the Show or Club Secretary before 7:00am Central time by phone on the day of the show, you will be promptly billed for your entry fees plus any reasonable expenses incurred to inform and collect from you. All we ask is that you please follow through by communicating that you will not be able to attend ASAP of knowing and before the deadline. Anyone who does not make any attempt to contact us may not be allowed to enter any shows in the future presented by the LCRBA until the amount due is paid in full. The LCRBA also has the right to require and only accept in person day of the show entries (at the cost listed for such) from the exhibitor for any future shows held regardless of their efforts to reconcile the debts owed and or personal history with the LCRBA.

DIRECTIONS TO SHOW SITE

GPS address: 27 Smith Rd. Lawrenceburg, TN 38464

From Interstate 65 (either traveling North or Southbound), take exit #14 onto US Highway 64 going Westbound towards Pulaski for approximately 31 miles. Continue on Highway 64; go pass the exit to Lawrenceburg to continue toward Waynesboro for 14 miles turn right off Highway 64 by the Dollar General store on to Scenic Road. Follow this to Genson Road, turn right and continue straight to Smith Road. The Laurel Hill Trail and Campground will be on the left.

OFFICIAL SHOW RULES

Official show rules in addition to any stated above, please contact the Show Secretary directly with any questions or concerns –

- 1. This show will be governed by the official ARBA show rules and submission of any entry indicates acceptance of those rules.
- 2. All changes must go thru the Show Secretary prior to judging the breed. No changes are allowed at the judging table. Unauthorized changes/additions will be ignored during the after show paperwork.
- 3. Entry fees must be paid prior to the start of the show. After paying, there will be no refunds on entries for any reason.
- 4. Check in will be from 6:30-7:30am Central time on day of show.
- 5. This is a no judging remark card show.
- 6. The Show Superintendent reserves the right to refuse any entry.
- 7. The Show Superintendent determines the judging order and reserves the right to reassign a judge as needed.
- 8. All carrying cages must be leak proof.
- 9. All rabbits must have a permanent and legible tattoo in the left ear in order to be entered into show.
- 10. Only exhibitors entered in the show can sell rabbits in the showroom. Rabbits entered in the show and then sold must be shown in the name originally entered, or scratched.
- 11. Youth exhibitors are responsible for getting their entries to the appropriate table.
- 12. The Show Secretary has the right to refuse any entries from all locations within 150 miles of a confirmed outbreak of RCD/RHD/VHD within 60 days of the entry deadline.
- 13. Parents are responsible for the actions of their children and for any damage done by them.
- 14. All reasonable care will be taken to provide a safe show; however, each exhibitor is ultimately responsible for all personal property to include their animals.
