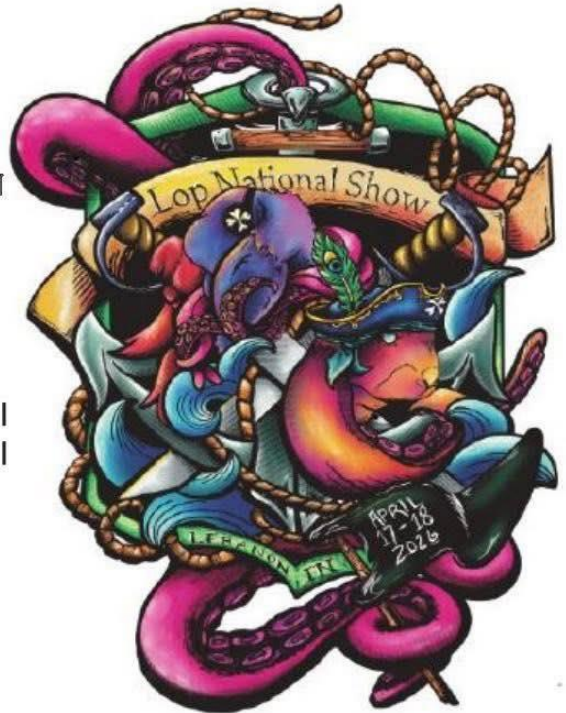

1. All entries must specify open or youth. Those not marked will be entered in open.
2. All rabbits must be permanently and legibly tattooed in the left ear.
3. For the Lop National show all animals must have their coop number (received at check in) written in their right ear. Markers will be available at check in.
4. Any animal not in their assigned coop or locked in at time of judging will be scratched.
5. Runners and runner tags will be used to bring animals to the tables. You will not put your own animals on the table.
6. No one other than show personnel are allowed behind the show tables during judging.
7. No animals under 8 weeks. No animals not making minimum show weight.
8. All French and English Lops in the showroom must be entered and cooped.
9. Any animals showing signs of illness or disease and/or unsightly specimens must be removed from the showroom. Entry fees will be forfeited.
10. The Illinois Lop Club, Lop Rabbit Club of America, Rabbit Renegades or the Boone County Fairgrounds are not responsible for any injury or accident occurring during the show.
11. Parents are responsible for damage done by their children.
12. No other animals except service animals allowed.
13. The ILC reserves the right to substitute or add judges as needed.
14. The show committee shall decide any and all questions which are not specifically covered by the show rules. All decisions will be final.
15. No smoking or E cigarettes allowed.
16. This is an official ARBA and LRCA sanctioned show. The latest revised rules of these associations will govern the show. Entering the show indicates your acceptance of these rules.
17. All comment cards and awards must be picked up at the show. They will not be mailed.
18. Exhibitors must be a LRCA member in good standing at time of judging to receive offered awards for the National show.

Tips on cooping your rabbits: ALWAYS check your cooped rabbits after the judging to make sure the ear# is your rabbit. It doesn't happen often, but it's extremely important to check that the right rabbit has been returned to the correct coop after judging.

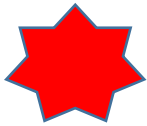

ENTRY INFORMATION

PLEASE DO NOT send your entries via facebook message, text, or by post/comment on the Facebook page. Please make sure to include each exhibitor's name, address, and phone number. Please also state clearly which shows you want each rabbit/cavy entered in. Include Ear Number, Breed, Variety, Class and Sex.

Email entries for Friday and Saturday Open and Youth All-breed shows and Friday specialty shows which are hosted by Rabbit Renegades or Central States Nomads to the address listed on the event page.

BE SURE THAT YOU RECEIVE AN EMAIL CONFIRMATION WITHIN 24 HOURS OF SUBMITTING YOUR ENTRY. If you don't receive one, your entry may not have been received. Please check in with the secretary.

Entry fees may be paid by cash or check at the time of check in. If you want to pre-pay we accept entries via PayPal at bobdonnell197021@yahoo.com. We do not accept credit cards.

All-Breed Best In Show Judging:

Best in show rabbits will be chosen at the end of the day after the completion of all shows. If you cannot stay for the conclusion of the last show, please arrange to leave your BOB animals with a friend for the BIS competitions.

SHOW RULES

1. This show will be governed by the latest [ARBA Show Rules](#) Filing of entries indicates acceptance of our show rules. Exhibitors are responsible for checking entries for errors and making changes BEFORE judging begins. Entry fees must be paid in full.
2. Exhibitors are responsible for all exhibitor fees. Should you enter and not attend, you may be billed for your entry fees. Your mail or email entry is a contract and fees are payable regardless of your attendance. Exhibitors that do not come to the show will be sent a bill and will not be allowed to enter animals in future Rabbit Renegade or Central States Nomad Shows until the bill is paid. Exceptions may be made in the case of emergency or unforeseen illness, as long as the show is notified prior to the show.
3. Neither the Rabbit Renegades, Central States Nomads or the venue will be responsible for loss in case of fire, theft or accident. All precautions will be taken for a safe show. All entries are entered and shown at the risk of the owners and while the Rabbit Renegades are expected to exercise all reasonable care in the handling and protection of the exhibits, such associations will in no case be liable.
4. Rabbit Renegades/Central States Nomads reserves the right to add, change, or substitute judges as the need may arise.
5. Any exhibitor indicating ownership, harassing, or interfering with a judge (or a writer) will be disqualified and forfeit all fees and winnings. No exhibitor will be allowed behind the judging tables, unless acting in an official capacity, which must be approved by the show superintendent or show secretary.
6. The show will start promptly at 8:00 a.m. local time. Please be on time.
7. Rabbits must be in leakproof carriers/cages.
8. Show management are compelled to refuse entry to show room and to remove from the same, all diseased or unsightly animals. All entry fees on such animals shall be forfeited.
9. This is a no comment card show – we will be using control sheets only at the judges table.
10. No dogs are allowed in the showroom without permission; Working Service Dogs will be admitted. If you see an animal in the building, other than rabbits or cavies, it's best to speak with the superintendent or secretary first.
11. **NO CHANGES MAY BE MADE AT THE JUDGING TABLES other than those approved by the show secretary. Unapproved changes may result in your animal being disqualified by the secretary after the show. Once a show starts, no changes will be made to the paperwork. ARBA Show Rules, Section 23 ... “No substitutions, changes, or additions will be allowed in a breed after judging of the breed has commenced.”**

12. No sales of any rabbits or cavies will be allowed by anyone not showing rabbits or cavies. Any exhibitor wishing to sell anything other than rabbits or cavies must pay a vendor fee and must receive permission BEFORE the show. No product pre-sales or pre-orders or deliveries may be made at the show site without permission - in the building or on the grounds.

NO DOGS ALLOWED

– Working Service Dogs will be admitted – Service Dogs in Training will NOT be admitted

Rabbit Renegades/Central States Nomad asks that any Service Animal that is brought to an event meet ADA requirements. We strictly enforce a leash law and ask that any service dog that is brought to the facility be kept on their leash and under control of the owner at all time, according to ADA requirements.
