SHOW RULES AND REGULATIONS

This official ARBA sanctioned show is governed by the latest revised rules of the ARBA. Submitting an entry indicates acceptance of these rules as well as the rules listed below.

1. Show Entries: All entries go to Laurie Krogen, Show Secretary, e-mailed with Ear Tag, Breed, Variety, Class, Sex. Include your address and phone number. Expect e-mail confirmation.
2. No substitutions except in same variety, sex, and class. For ear tags or day of show entries check-in before 8 AM.
3. All entries must be the bona-fide property of the exhibitor & must have permanent ear tag or tattoo in the left ear. Ear tagging will be available at the show. Come early.
4. CHILDREN must be supervised & parents will be held responsible

for actions of their children.

6. North Carolina Cavy Breeders Association and the VFW Post 4309 will not be responsible for loss in case of fire, accident, theft or providential destruction; however, every precaution will be taken to safeguard you & your stock.
 7. Exhibitors are responsible for carrying their own animals to and from the table. Youth are encouraged to carry their own covies whenever possible.
 9. Any cavy showing signs of disease will be isolated and the entry fee forfeited. Show superintendent, Margie Lussier or Valerie Blaes will each have the authority to direct isolation of any cavy who appears ill or with potentially contagious skin condition or parasites. This applies to both show covies or ones present to sell or buy.
 10. Any exhibitor indicating ownership of covies on the judging table, harassing, interfering or attempting to influence a judge will be disqualified and forfeit all fees and winnings.
 11. The NCCBA reserves the right to substitute awards or judges.
 12. Please respect areas of the building that are off limits to our group. No smoking in the showroom or at doorways.
 13. Only covies and service animals are permitted in the room.
