NWRB Youth Scholarship

About the Scholarship:


The Northwest Rabbit Breeders Scholarship is designed to help and encourage youth in its club to attend the National ARBA Convention. Attending the National ARBA Convention is a great opportunity for youth to further their rabbit and cavy goals, connect with others from across the country, and to grow as an exhibitor or competitor. **This scholarship is not limited to youth who intend to compete in Youth Royalty events, but youth must be entering animals if they are not competing in Royalty events.** The scholarship amount will be determined by the amount raised in the silent auction or raffle of animals at a designated show with a maximum of \$400 per youth.

Scholarship Requirements:

Applicants must be current members of ARBA and the Northwest Rabbit Breeders club in good standing and have joined the club by February 28 of the current year to qualify. Youth must fill out the Google Doc application and submit it to NWRB by September 15 th .

Additionally, youth must complete the following to qualify for the scholarship:

- 1) Donate at least 4 hours of their time helping the club at shows (table writing, set up, raffle, etc.), including sourcing rabbits for the auction
- 2) Attend 4 club meetings during the current year
- 3) Give a report to the club on some aspect of raising rabbits, including why they want to attend the national convention



Youth should help procure animals for the auction and help at the show selling raffle tickets or keeping an eye on the silent auction sheets.

Before funds are dispersed, proof of entry at ARBA Convention must be submitted. As a requirement of the scholarship, if selected, the recipients must sign up to present to the club what they learned at convention and talk about their experiences.

Show Rules

This is an official ARBA show. All rabbits will be judged by the latest ARBA Standard of Perfection, and this show is governed by the official ARBA show rules as printed in the latest ARBA yearbook. Submission of entry indicates acceptance of these rules.

- 1. Anyone wishing to work with any of the judges must secure approval from both the show superintendent and the judge prior to the show.
- 2. Entry fees must accompany the entry. No rabbit will be judged until entries are paid for.
- 3. These are one-day carrying cage shows; leak-proof bottoms are required on all carriers.
- 4. Rabbits must have a legible tattoo in their left ear.
- 5. The judges' decisions are final. There will be no interference with judges or judging.
- 6. Final interpretation of the rules is vested in the show committee. Any problems or questions will be referred to the show superintendent.
- 7. Only the judge, table writers, and other table help will be allowed behind the judging tables.
- 8. Per ARBA, youth exhibitors between the ages of 5 and 19 years may enter a sanctioned youth show. An adult cannot show in the youth classes at any time. Youth exhibitors must be able to handle their own animals. Youth exhibitors are not required to carry their own animals to the judging table, but all youth entries must be placed on the table by a youth, owner, or other.
- 9. Rabbits are entered at the sole risk of the owners. The greatest care possible will be given to all exhibits, but the management will not be responsible for any illness, accidents, loss, mistakes, or damage that occurs.
- 10. All rabbits entered in fur classes must also be entered in regular classes.
- 11. Any rabbit exhibiting signs of disease will not be judged or allowed to remain in the showroom.
- 12. Northwest Rabbit Breeders reserves the right to substitute and/or add judges as necessary.
- 13. Children must be supervised by an adult. Any damage will be the responsibility of the parent or guardian.
- 14. All rabbits will be judged in the class as entered. Make out your entry carefully and be sure to include breed, variety, sex, and ear number.
- 15. Underage animals will not be allowed in the showroom. Rabbits must meet their breed minimum weights to be in the showroom.

No changes are allowed at the table without the show secretary's permission.


