ENTRY FEES AND DEADLINES (O & Y):

(No refunds on entries made then scratched at check-in.)

PRE-ENTRY at \$4.00 per rabbit, per show until Tuesday 12/9/25 at 11 PM CST.

LATE ENTRY at \$5.00 per rabbit, per show will be taken on Wednesday 12/10/25 until 10 PM CST.

NO ENTRIES will be taken on THURSDAY or FRIDAY.

DAY OF SHOW is \$6.00 per rabbit, per show. (Please check-in by 7:00 AM, CST.)

FUR CLASS is \$2.00 per rabbit, per show.

REGISTRAR: Donna Barabas (AL). Bring your ARBA Card, Pedigree (or copy), Rabbit and \$6.00.

AWARDS : BIS & RESERVE; BOB and BOS Rosettes for sanctioned breeds showing 10 or more in each open show and any breed showing 10 or more in the youth show. YOUTH BREEDS showing less than (10) in Youth A & B will get a Flat Ribbon for BOB/BOS.

WE WILL HAVE A NICE PHOTO TABLE SET UP, SO PLAN ON USING IT... (This will be located near check in table as always).

RAFFLE TABLE: THERE WILL BE A RAFFLE TABLE AND/OR SILENT AUCTION. Quality donations and Christmas items are always appreciated to help raise funds for the club. If donating a rabbit with a pedigree please bring the pedigree.

FOOD (Breakfast & Lunch): Restaurant @ The Detention will have a full menu along with a hot bar and salad bar.

DIRECTIONS: Take Exit 111 off I-24.

I-24 West get off and go right on Hwy 55 heading east bound. I-24 East get off and go right, on to Hwy 55 heading east bound.

You will be going approximately 11 miles, Turning Left onto West Maple Street (Hwy 379). Half Mile on the Left will be the venue.

The Detention at the Elementary

There will be a unloading area and then proceed to the parking lot to park.

This Venue has many attractions under 1 roof. Arcade, Restaurant, Party Rooms, Miniature Golf, Meeting Rooms, Bounce House Room.

MOTELS (in Manchester): I-24, Exit 110 there is Econolodge, Hampton Inn & Suites, America's Best Value, Days Inn, Ambassador Inn. At I-24, Exit 114 there is Red Roof, Motel 6, Quality Inn, Sleep Inn, Comfort Suites, Holiday Inn Express, Microtel.

RESTUARANTS (in Manchester): I-24, Exit 110 there is Oaks Family Restaurant, Cracker Barrel, Emmas, Los 3 Amigos, Waffle House, Prater's BBQ. At I-24, Exit 114 there is a Logans and an Old Charlies, Zaxby's, KFC, Wendy's, Burger King.

CAMPGROUND (in Manchester): Old Stone Fort State Park will be open with water & electric hookups and a dump station. There is a bathhouse available but the showers are closed in December.

** Manchester is approximately 30 minutes from the venue. **

Official Show Rules

1. You do not need a health certificate if you have not come in contact with RHVD2 in the past 8 months.
2. The shows are governed by the Official ARBA Show Rules and filing an entry indicates acceptance of those rules and the ones listed below.
3. ALL changes must go thru the Show Secretary prior to judging the breed. Changes at the judging tables are against ARBA Rules.
4. Entries must be paid for prior to judging. No refunds on entries made then scratched at check-in.
5. Judges will make comments but writers only have to list placements, judge's name and awards.
6. No exhibitor will be allowed behind the judging tables unless acting in an official capacity which must be approved by the Show Superintendent or Show Secretary.
7. The Superintendent reserves the right to refuse any entry and to remove from the showroom all diseased or unsightly animals. Entry fees on such animals will be forfeited.
8. The Superintendent determines the judging order and reserves the right to reassign a judge as needed to keep the show moving.
9. All carrying cages must be leak proof and have water provided for each rabbit.
10. Each Rabbit in the show(s) must have a permanent and legible tattoo in it's LEFT ear.
11. ONLY Youth can put entries on the youth table.

12. Exhibitors (Open & Youth) are responsible for getting their rabbits to and from the judging tables. We will make 3 calls, from the judging table, and then the rabbits on the table will be judged. Rabbits not on the table will be passed over. Judging for Show B may start before Youth or Show A finishes. Please make sure you are listening for your breed so that you are not passed over for judging.
13. Only exhibitors entered in the all breed show(s) can sell rabbits/cavies in the showroom. Rabbits/Cavies must be 8 weeks old to sell (TN State Law).
14. Rabbits entered in the show and then sold must be shown in the name originally entered or scratched.
15. Parents are responsible for the actions of their children and for any damage done by their children.
16. Though every precaution will be taken, neither Detention at the Elementary nor the individuals working the show will be responsible for the loss of any rabbit or any injury. Each exhibitor is ultimately responsible for all personal property including animals.
