SHOW RULES

1. When making an entry, you agree that you **MUST** pay for your entries should you not attend.
2. To be sure that our show starts ON TIME, all exhibitors must be Checked-in and have ALL Day of Show Entries submitted by 3:30 pm to allow time for the show secretary to get entries into the judge's folders and to their tables. For Show B, entries are closed once folders are at the judge's table.
3. Specialty Shows start at 2 pm. All Breed Judging starts promptly at 4 pm. Exhibitors need to be ready on time.
4. All animals are entered and shown at the risk of the owner. TTRC will not be responsible in case of fire, theft, accident or providential destruction. However, every precaution will be taken to eliminate danger.
5. TTRC reserves the right to substitute a judge or judges at any time it deems necessary.
6. All entries must have a legible permanent tattoo in the left ear.
7. Exhibitors are responsible for printing their own entry sheets prior to the show and verifying all entries.
8. Scratches will be done at the judge's tables. No refunds given for scratched entries.
9. No changes can be made at the judge's table unless approved by the show secretary or show superintendent.
10. Any animal showing signs of sickness or disease will be immediately removed from the showroom, without refunds.
11. This is a carrying case show. All carrying cages **MUST** have leak proof bottoms. ANY cage found leaking will be removed from the show room. Space is tight; please stack carriers and be considerate of fellow exhibitors.
12. Absolutely **NO** breeding of stock in the show room.
13. Absolutely **NO Cats, Birds or Dogs allowed** in the show room, **EXCEPT registered and leased service animals. Service Animals causing disruption (barking) or those not under the control of a handler, will be asked to leave. Dogs whose sole function is to provide comfort or emotional support do not qualify as service animals under the ADA.**
 - a. A service animal must be under the control of its handler. Under the ADA, service animals must be harnessed, leashed, or tethered, unless the individual's disability prevents using these devices or these devices interfere with the service animal's safe, effective performance of tasks. In that case, the individual must maintain control of the animal through voice, signal, or other effective controls.
14. All exhibitors are responsible for getting their animals to the show table promptly. There will be **NO** more than **TWO (2) CALLS** for a class. After that, any animal not on the table will be disqualified.
15. Payment for entry fees must be made at check-in before showing, and will mean that the exhibitor agrees to comply with all A.R.B.A. rules and those rules set forth in this catalog.
16. Anyone causing a disruption or attempting to intimidate a judge, show staff or fellow exhibitor, **WILL** immediately be asked to leave the show and will forfeit all show fees.
17. ALL PRIZES must be picked up before leaving the show.
18. CHILDREN MUST BE UNDER PARENTAL CONTROL **AT ALL TIMES**, otherwise both will be asked to leave the show and entry money will be forfeited.

RHD Rules

1. The TTRC Show will follow all guidance put out by the ARBA (www.visit arba.net for details)

Covid-19 Mandates

1. TTRC asks all Exhibitors to comply with all NY State Covid-19 Mandates as of the date of the show.
2. Exhibitors may bring a pop-up tent for outdoor shelter.
