We will have a registrar available. The cost is \$6.00 per rabbit. You must have your ARBA Card present, along with a complete pedigree.

It is the policy of the WSRBA and RRB that rabbits must make the minimum weight for their breed, in order to be in the showroom!!

SHOW RULES

1. This will be an Official ARBA show governed by the Official Show Rules in the 2021-2024 ARBA Yearbook. All rabbits will be judged by the ARBA Standard of Perfection 2026-2030 edition.
2. All rabbits and cavies will be judged as written on the entry forms and all changes must be approved by the show secretary. Ear changes \$ 2.00 each. Any change made without Secretary approval will result in animal being scratched and all winnings forfeited.
3. All rabbits must have a permanent & legible tattoo in the left ear.
4. Make all checks payable to Rebel Rabbit Breeders in US Funds. In addition to any bank charges a \$30.00 fee will be charged for any returned checks.
5. Entry Fees must be paid when entries are submitted. No entry will be judged prior to fees being paid.
6. All entries must be paid whether the rabbits are judged or not. (No refunds on Scratched animals)
7. RRB reserves the right to add, substitute, or cancel judges as conditions require.
8. Judge's decisions will be final. Interfering with the judging will not be tolerated. The final interpretation of the show rules is the responsibility of the show committee. Breeders are encouraged to volunteer as table help during the judging of their breeds.
9. With the exception of the judge, table secretary, table superintendent no one will be allowed behind the table, other than exhibitors placing their entries into the judging coops.
10. Each person is responsible for bringing their rabbits to the judging table when called. No class will be rejudged!
11. All entries shall be entered at the sole risk of their owner. The greatest possible care will be given to your entries however, the RRB will not be responsible for injury to animals.
12. No animals other than rabbits/cavies allowed in the showroom
13. Legs and show reports will be mailed or emailed. Awards and comment cards must be picked up at the show.
14. Children must be supervised at all times by an adult, damages by children will be the responsibility of their parents.
15. **This is a carrying cage show. Leak proof cage bottoms are required.**
16. Underage animals will not be allowed in the showroom!! Rabbits must meet their breed's minimum weight to be in the showroom.
17. RRB will follow all rules and guidelines set forth by the ARBA in regards to RHVD2 and reserve the right to refuse entry from anyone known to be in violation of ARBA Guidelines.
18. Submitting an entry indicates acceptance of these rules and promise to pay all fees whether or not you or your animals attend the show!
19. No Dogs allowed in showroom, except official service dogs without permission of the show committee!!
20. ALL Youth animals entered MUST be owned by the youth exhibiting the animal. Violation of this will result in disqualifying of all entries and forfeiting of entry fees.
21. A YOUTH (between the ages of 5-18) must place the youth animals on the show table, unless permission is granted from Show Superintendent.
22. Rebel Rabbit Breeders reserve the right to add, retract or modify any show rule as needed.
