## SHOW RULES:

1. This is an ARBA sanctioned show and will be governed by the latest ARBA show rules. Filing of an entry indicates acceptance of these rules. Interpretation of the show rules will be by the show officials.
2. DAY OF SHOW ENTRY: \$3.00 per animal Open shows. Make checks payable to RENO COUNTY FAIR. A \$35.00 surcharge will be assessed for a check returned unpaid. Until the check is paid, exhibitors will not be allowed to enter any further Salt City shows nor be granted their sweepstakes points.
3. Pre entry show, Day of show entry accepted, do not need to be pre entered. No changes allowed without show secretary approval once show starts.
4. Entry consists of entry sheet and control sheet. All rabbits must be entered in the name of the bona fide owner. All fur entries must be entered in the regular class.
5. ALL CHANGES MUST BE MADE ON THE ENTRY FORM PRIOR TO JUDGING WITH THE OFFICIAL SHOW SECRETARY – CHANGES AT THE TABLE ARE NOT VALID. Per Section 23 of the ARBA Official Show Rules: “...No substitutions, changes, or additions will be allowed in a breed after judging if the breed has commenced.” The rabbit entered must match the control sheet if they do not match, the rabbit/cavy may be given a “no place” award.
6. Owners are responsible for getting their own rabbits to the show table. Carriers are not provided. ALL RABBITS ENTERED IN THE YOUTH DIVISION MUST BE CARRIED TO THE SHOW TABLE BY A YOUTH. YOUTH ENTRIES HANDLED BY AN ADULT WILL BE TRANSFERRED TO THE OPEN DIVISION. ADULTS MAY ASSIST REMOVAL ONLY and extenuating circumstances.
7. All rabbits must be permanently and legibly ear marked or they may be disqualified from competition.
8. Any animal showing signs of illness or disease and/or unsightly specimens must be removed from the show room. Entry fees on such specimens will be forfeited.
9. Neither the Reno County Fair Board or the Kansas State Fair Grounds will be responsible for any injury or accident occurring during the show. Please understand the below Kansas law before entering, it is also posted in the show room. KS LAW K.S.A. 60-4001 THROUGH 60-4004 UNDER KANSAS LAW, THERE IS NO LIABILITY FOR AN INJURY TO OR DEATH OF A PARTICIPANT IN DOMESTIC ANIMAL ACTIVITIES RESULTING FROM THE INHERENT RISKS OF DOMESTIC ANIMAL ACTIVITIES, PURSUANT TO SECTIONS 1 THROUGH 4 YOU ARE ASSUMING THE RISK OF PARTICIPATING IN THIS DOMESTIC ANIMAL ACTIVITY.
10. EXHIBITORS ARE RESPONSIBLE AND EXPECTED TO CLEAN UP THEIR AREA BEFORE LEAVING. Parents are responsible for damage done by their children, please keep track of them. We will do all within our power to have a safe show, please do the same.
11. Reno County Fair reserves the right to substitute or add a judge or judges if necessary.
12. Grooming tables wagons/carts and chairs MUST NOT block aisles and walkways.
13. Wool Breeds are asked to groom outside if possible
14. No Rideable toys allowed in the building
