NO DOGS ALLOWED

– Working Service Dogs will be admitted – Service Dogs in Training will NOT be admitted.

ALL Dogs MUST be on a leash AT ALL TIMES in the building or on the grounds

Leash must be no longer than 6 ft leash

Set up will start at 3:30 pm Friday. If you can help, we would really appreciate it!
You can drop off animals and do early check-in from 5:00 pm – 8:45 pm on
Friday Sept 26. The building will be locked PROMPTLY at 9 pm.

Building will open at 6 am on Saturday for the show.

SHOW RULES and GENERAL INFORMATION

1. This show will be governed by the latest rules of the ARBA. Filing of entries indicates acceptance of our show rules.
2. Neither the West Georgia RC nor Carroll County Ag-Ed Center will be responsible for loss in case of fire, theft or accident. All precautions will be taken for a safe show. All entries are entered and shown at the risk of the owners and while the West Georgia RC nor Carroll County Ag-Ed Center are expected to exercise all reasonable care in the handling and protection of the exhibits, such associations will in no case be liable.
3. All rabbits and cavies must be permanently and legibly ear marked.
4. WGRC reserves the right to add, change, or substitute judges as the need may arise.
5. Exhibitors or guardians of exhibitors attempting to, or actually interfering with, annoying, molesting, or influencing the judge or judges, or acting in a manner unbecoming an exhibitor(s) shall have all their stock disqualified by the judge and shall be ejected by the show superintendent and barred from the show room. All fees and winnings may be forfeited. No exhibitor or any other person will be allowed behind the judging tables, unless acting in an official capacity, which must be approved by the show superintendent or show secretary. Any behavior deemed inappropriate by the club's BOD, in the showroom or on the grounds, can result in expulsion from the facility, scratching of entries without refund, and future penalties based on the severity of the behavior. Inappropriate behavior can include, but is not limited to, verbal or physical contact between attendees, mistreatment of property or animals, or harassment of other attendees, show staff, or judges. The club's BOD will make the determination of what is "inappropriate", and their decision will be final.

Children should be supervised at all times – indoors and outdoors. NO running in the buildings/show areas. NO climbing! NO playing under or behind judging tables, or in the bathrooms or in vendor's booth area. No use of loud electronics (please use headphones). Children are not allowed on the judging tables.

6. The show will start promptly at 8:00 a.m. EST. Please be on time.
7. Rabbits and cavies must be in leakproof carriers/cages
8. Show management are compelled to refuse entry to show room and to remove from the same, all diseased or unsightly animals. All entry fees on such animals shall be forfeited.
9. This is a no comment card show – we will be using control sheets only at the judges table.
10. Dogs are not allowed in the showroom without permission; Working Service Dogs will be admitted. Dogs are allowed on the grounds but not in the buildings but must be on a leash. All dogs, including service dogs, must be tethered or on a hand held, 6 foot (or shorter) leash AT ALL TIMES, according to ADA regs! If you break this rule, your entries will be scratched without a refund and you will need to leave the building and grounds immediately. Dogs are not allowed to run loose anywhere on the grounds at any time. If you see an animal in the building, other than rabbits or cavies, it's best to speak with the superintendent or secretary first
11. Each parent is accountable for the actions and/or conduct of their child/children at the show site. If any damages occur, you will be financially responsible for the repair or replacement of the damages. NO SKATEBOARDS, roller skates/rollerblades, scooters, etc are allowed in the building or on the property.
12. Adults are not to place rabbits on or off the show table for the youth shows. All youth entries must be carried to the show table by a youth. Exhibitors do not have to carry their own animals to the show table.
13. Exhibitors are responsible for checking entries for errors and making changes BEFORE judging begins. NO CHANGES MAY BE MADE AT THE JUDGING TABLES other than those approved by the show secretary. Unapproved changes may result in your animal being disqualified by the secretary after the show. Once a show starts, no changes will be made to the paperwork. ARBA Show Rules, Section 23 ... "No substitutions, changes, or additions will be allowed in a breed after judging of the breed has commenced. PLEASE CHECK ALL YOUR PAPERWORK before the show starts – each sheet for each show! YOU are responsible for the information that is on the check-in sheets. If there is an error, either because the secretary typed it wrong or because you provided the information wrong, you must make the changes BEFORE the change deadline.

14. Entry fees must be paid in full. Exhibitors are responsible for all exhibitor fees. If an animal is scratched from the show, exhibitors must pay for the scratched entry. Should you enter and not attend, you will be billed for your entry fees. Your mail, email or online entry is a contract and fees are payable regardless of your attendance. Exhibitors that do not come to the show will be sent a bill and will not be allowed to enter animals in future Georgia shows until the bill is paid. You enter, you owe.
15. Exhibitors are responsible for getting their rabbits to and from the judging tables. We will make 3 calls for judging and then the rabbits on the table will be judged; rabbits not on the table will be passed over. Judging for Show B may start before Show A finishes. Please make sure you are listening for your breed so that you are not passed over for judging.
16. No rabbits under 8 weeks of age will be allowed on the show premises.
17. No sales of any rabbits or cavies will be allowed by anyone not showing rabbits or cavies. No animals are allowed on the property (building or grounds) for sale, trade, transport, display, delivery, culls, or gift by anyone not showing rabbits or cavies. Visitors (anyone not entered in the show) may not carry rabbits/cavies/other animals around the building or grounds or bring them into the building for evaluation without prior permission. Any exhibitor wishing to sell anything other than rabbits or cavies must pay a vendor fee and must receive permission BEFORE the show. No product pre-sales or pre-orders or deliveries may be made at the show site without permission - in the building or on the grounds.
18. Cull buyers must apply to the club, no later than 2 weeks before show date, for permission to pick up culls on the show site.
19. YOUTH SHOW RULES – are the SAME as for Open shows.
20. ARBA Show Rules Youth
Section 51. Youth may not enter their rabbit or cavy in both open and youth classes at the same show, which is sponsored by the same club. Youth may make entries in both open and youth classes with different animals.
21. All Georgia state guidelines for RHDV apply. “Exhibition of rabbits does not require a CVI unless required by the individual show authority. Georgia requires an official CVI issued within the previous 30 days for rabbits entering for sale, trade, adoption, or exchange for a fee or other type of compensation”

22. Only current ARBA recognized breeds and varieties, or breeds and varieties with a current Certificate of Development will be allowed to be shown, as per ARBA rules. Please bring a copy of a working standard for the judges.
23. No Balloons in the buildings.
24. Do not take pictures or videos of animals or people without permission. Photography at events is allowed but photos may not be used for commercial gain without written permission from the club and the individuals pictured
25. Please note the following recommendations:
 - a) Exhibitors should follow ARBA recommended biosecurity guidelines.
 - b) Exhibitors and show officials should wash the undercarriage and tires of all vehicles and trailers before going to and after departing a show.
 - c) Exhibitors residing in a state with a confirmed case of RHDV in the past 30 days should have a health certificate (CVI) issued within fourteen (14) days of the show.
 - d) Use an appropriate disinfectant that will inactivate RHDV.
 - e) The ARBA club show committee has the right to refuse any entry for due cause.
 - f) The ARBA recommends carrying cages be cleaned prior to going to a show. The ARBA recommends the following products: kitty litter, newspaper, puppy pads, or other inert products used for bedding.
 - g) State and county officials may impose additional stricter sanctions / requirements.
 - h) Show officials can designate additional requirements to attend an ARBA sanctioned show.
 - i) If you are not comfortable with the provisions in (D), please continue to maintain biosecurity at your residence.

ADA Regs regarding Service Animals

Q1

Under the ADA, a service animal is defined as a dog that has been individually trained to do work or perform tasks for an individual with a disability. The task(s) performed by the dog must be directly related to the person's disability.

Q23

....However, if a particular service animal behaves in a way that poses a direct threat to the health or safety of others, has a history of such behavior, or is not under the control of the handler, that animal may be excluded.

Q27

The ADA requires that service animals be under the control of the handler at all times.....The service animal must be harnessed, leashed, or tethered while in public places unless these devices interfere with the service animal's work or the person's disability prevents use of these devices. may not allow the dog to wander away from her and must maintain control of the dog

This means that there will be no barking, whining, no signs of aggression (including low growling and baring teeth), no service dogs not under the DIRECT control of the handler, no disruptive behavior, etc. Your service dog must be leashed, harnessed, or tethered at all times and you must be in CONSTANT control of the leash.

To maintain and continue the great relationship currently enjoyed, it is important that EVERYONE follows the rules and requests of the facility.

1. This is an alcohol and smoking free facility. There is to be NO ALCOHOL anywhere on the property at any time.
2. There is to be no use of tobacco ANYWHERE inside the building at any time. There is a DESIGNATED SMOKING AREA – signs will be posted. Smokers may not smoke within 20 feet of the doors. ABSOLUTELY NO SMOKING in the Cattle Pavilion – there are SHAVINGS on the ground/floor.
3. This is an AIR CONDITONED building. Door MUST remain closed – please limit your exits and entrances during the day after the show starts at 8:00 am on Saturday morning.
4. DO NOT dump your carrier dropping pans in the parking lot!!
5. There is a nice, gravel parking area at the facility, with additional parking area at the rear of the cattle sheds. DO NOT park on their grass in front of the building. DO NOT block the driveways.

Electric is limited to 110v only – bring an extension cord or two. Spots with access to 110 outlet - \$15.00. Spots with no electric or water hook up - \$5.00 (registration and permit card fee). To clarify: if you plug in at any time, for camping purposes, you will need to pay for an electric site. There are no bathroom facilities. The building is locked from 9 pm till 6 am.
