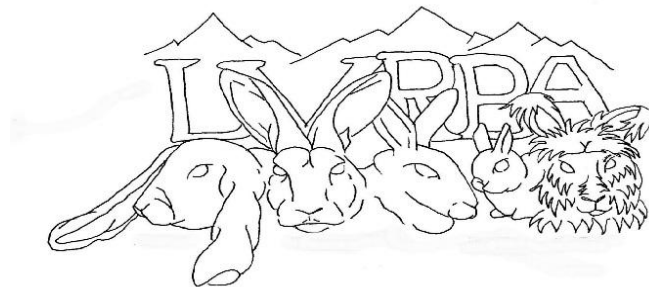

Show Rules Include but are not limited to:

- This is an official ARBA sanctioned show. By submitting an entry, you have indicated that you will abide by LVRBA's show rules and the rules of the ARBA, which govern this show.
- LVRBA follows ARBA guidelines for RHDV. These guidelines are subject to change per ARBA. Visit www.arba.net for current guidelines.
- You are attending this show at your own risk.
- The LVRBA, or the owner, agent, organization or the show facility, or any other related organization or any individuals relating to the event you are attending, will not be held responsible for any type of loss or injury due to fire, accident, or providential destruction under any circumstances to any person, animal, or personal property, whether owned, borrowed, or rented, or due to any complications or interactions related to COVID-19, RHDV2 or any other disease.
- By submitting your entries, you agree to the following statements: I acknowledge the contagious nature of Coronavirus/COVID-19 and that the CDC and many other public health authorities still recommend practicing social distancing. I acknowledge the contagious nature of Rabbit Hemorrhagic Disease Virus 2/(RHDV2) and that the state vet of Wyoming, and many other public health authorities still recommend practicing self-quarantining. I further acknowledge that LVRBA volunteers cannot guarantee that I, or my rabbits will not become infected with the Coronavirus/COVID-19 or Rabbit Hemorrhagic Disease virus (RHDV2) respectively. I understand that the risk of becoming exposed to and/or infected by the Coronavirus/COVID-19 or Rabbit Hemorrhagic Disease virus 2/(RHDV2) respectively may result from the actions, omissions, or negligence of myself and others, including, but not limited to, volunteers, exhibitors, and their families. I voluntarily seek to participate in the event provided by LVRBA volunteers and acknowledge that I must comply with all set procedures to reduce the virus spread while participating at this event.
- The State of Wyoming requires a Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (CVI or Health Certificate) if crossing state lines. LVRBA will not be checking CVIs.

- ARBA Show Rule 30, All animals must be the bonafide property of the exhibitor(s) prior to entry. Each owner's personal name(s) must be listed on the entry form, but a rabbitry name may be added, if applicable, when entering shows.
- Show starts promptly at 9 AM. LVRBA cannot accept day of show entries.
- Pre-entry e-mails without payment are allowed but assumes payment will be made before the show begins. If payment is not made, entries in future shows will not be accepted without full payment of previous entries. All entries will need to be paid for even if you do not attend or if you scratch any rabbits before the show.
- All entries must be paid before the start of the show. There will be a \$35.00 charge for all NSF checks. Make checks payable to LVRBA.
- Judging order will be posted Saturday morning prior to the start of the show.
- Youth cannot enter the same rabbit in an open all breed show as they have entered in a youth all breed show. Youth can show in the Open show with different animals. Youth are required to place their animals on/off the show coops. Adults cannot show in a youth show.
- All rabbits must have A PERMANENT, LEGIBLE TATTOO IN THE LEFT EAR, or they could be eliminated.
- All fur entries must be entered in their breed class. Unless another fur class is requested, all fur entries will be judged in breed fur.
- This is a BASKET SHOW: solid bottom carriers only please.
- Exhibitors are responsible for getting their rabbits to the judging table when the class is called. Each class will be called three times. There will be no re-judging of a class.
- SUBSTITUTIONS will be allowed in the SAME BREED, CLASS, VARIETY AND SEX ONLY. Substitutions will be taken at the time the rabbit is brought to the table to be shown; it is the exhibitor's responsibility to advise the show personnel of the changes **before** judging of the class begins.
- LVRBA reserves the right to add or substitute judges, if necessary. Please pick up your prizes at the show table. They will not be mailed. There will be no payback for this show. Prizes will be given to sanctioned open breeds, sponsored awards, and all youth breeds.
- The restrooms are located inside the Activity Building. DO NOT enter any other buildings on the fairgrounds without consent. You are responsible for your children and any damage you or they may cause.
- No dogs allowed in the barn. No rabbits less than eight weeks of age allowed in the barn.
- **NO SMOKING in any building**. If you do smoke, please do so outside at a reasonable distance from buildings and pick up your cigarette butts when finished. Thanks.
- Exhibitors should clean their area when finished showing.
- Exhibitors may use the provided photo booth at their own risk.

DIRECTIONS TO SHOW

Albany County Fairgrounds | 3510 S 3rd Street | Laramie, WY

If coming from the West on Interstate 80- take exit 313 and a right onto Hwy 287 South. The fairgrounds are located on the right-hand side of the road a mile from the interstate. Take the main entrance to the fairgrounds located across the road from the Port of Entry.

If coming from the East on Interstate 80 - take exit 313 and a left onto Hwy 287 South. The fairgrounds are located on the right-hand side of the road a mile from the interstate. Take the main entrance to the fairgrounds located across the road from the Port of Entry.

If coming from the North on Hwy 287, go through Laramie, under Interstate 80 and travel approximately one mile, turn right into the main fairground entrance.

If coming from the South on 287, approximately one mile south of Laramie, across from the Port of Entry, you will find the fairgrounds on the left side of the road.
