
You can drop off animals and do early check-in from 5:00 pm until 8:30 pm on Friday March 1.

NO ANIMALS will be allowed in the building before 5:00 pm unless you are helping with set up

There will be NO saving space for other exhibitors after 7:00 am on Saturday. A few years ago, we had exhibitors who had to set up outside because they couldn't find room inside the building. After 7:00 am we will be compressing any spaces that we think are taking up too much room so that we have enough space for the exhibitors that come in on Saturday morning. The building opens at 6:00 am on Saturday.

Everyone should bring only essentials - one chair per person or less, but no more. If you have them, bring tables to place your rabbits on and put your "stuff" under the tables. Tables should be used to conserve space; no wasted space on or under tables. Tighten up your spots so there's no wasted space. Stack carriers if you can. NO empty carts in the building unless they are being stored under a table or carriers. Exhibitors should make every effort to be at the show room as early as possible on Saturday.

NW Georgia CRC SHOW RULES and GENERAL INFORMATION

- 1. This show will be governed by the latest rules of the ARBA. Filing of entries indicates acceptance of our show rules.
- 2. Neither the NWGCRC nor North GA Fairgrounds will be responsible for loss in case of fire, theft or accident. All precautions will be taken for a safe show. All entries are entered and shown at the risk of the owners and while the NWGCRC and North GA Fairgrounds are expected to exercise all reasonable care in the handling and protection of the exhibits, such associations will in no case be liable.
- 3. NWGCRC reserves the right to add, change, or substitute judges as the need may arise.
- 4. Exhibitors or guardians of exhibitors attempting to, or actually interfering with, annoying, molesting, or influencing the judge or judges, or acting in a manner unbecoming an exhibitor(s) shall have all their stock disqualified by the judge and shall be ejected by the show superintendent and barred from the show room. All fees and winnings may be forfeited. No exhibitor or any other person will be allowed behind the judging tables, unless acting in an official capacity, which must be approved by the show superintendent or show secretary. Any behavior deemed inappropriate by the club's BOD, in the showroom or on the grounds, can result in expulsion from the facility, scratching of entries without refund, and future penalties based on the severity of the behavior. Inappropriate behavior can include, but is not limited to, verbal or physical contact between attendees, mistreatment of property or animals, or harassment of other attendees, show staff, or judges. The club's BOD will make the determination of what is "inappropriate", and their decision will be final

Children should be supervised at all times – indoors and outdoors. NO running in the buildings/show areas. NO climbing! NO playing under or behind judging tables, or in the bathrooms or in vendor's booth area. No use of loud electronics (please use headphones), no yelling or screaming near the rabbits, judging tables or other exhibitors. Use your inside voice Children are not allowed on the judging tables. The show will start promptly at 8:00 a.m. EST. Please be on time.

- 5. Rabbits and cavies must be in leak-proof carriers/cages
- 6. Show management are compelled to refuse entry to show room and to remove from the same, all diseased or unsightly animals. All entry fees on such animals shall be forfeited.
- 7. This is a no comment card show we will be using control sheets only at the judges table.
- 8. CHECK ALL YOUR PAPERWORK before the show starts each sheet for each show! YOU are responsible for the information that is on the check-in sheets. If there is an error, either because the secretary typed it wrong or because you provided the information wrong, you must make the changes BEFORE the deadline on TUESDAY, except \$1 for ear # changes. NO CHANGES MAY BE MADE AT THE JUDGING TABLES other than those approved by the show secretary. Unapproved changes may result in your animal being disqualified by the secretary after the show. Once a show starts, no changes will be made to the paperwork. ARBA Show Rules, Section 23 ... "No substitutions, changes, or additions will be allowed in a breed after judging of the breed has commenced."
- 9. Dogs are not allowed in the showroom without permission; Working Service Dogs will be admitted. Dogs are allowed on the grounds but not in the buildings. All dogs, including service dogs, must be on a tethered or hand held, 6 foot (or shorter) leash AT ALL TIMES, according to ADA regs! If you break this rule, your entries will be scratched without a refund and you will need to leave the building and grounds immediately. Dogs are not allowed to run loose anywhere on the grounds at any time. If you see an animal in the building, other than rabbits or cavies, it's best to speak with the superintendent or secretary first
- Each parent is accountable for the actions and/or conduct of their child/children at the show site. If any damages occur, you will be financially responsible for the repair or replacement of the damages. NO SKATEBOARDS, roller skates/rollerblades, scooters, etc. are allowed in the building or on the Fair property.

- 11. Adults are not to place rabbits on or off the show table for the youth shows. All youth entries must be carried to the show table by a youth. Exhibitors do not have to carry their own animals to the show table.
- 12. Cull buyers must apply to the club, no later than 2 weeks before show date, for permission to pick up culls on the show site.
- 13. Exhibitors are responsible for checking entries for errors and making changes BEFORE judging begins. NO CHANGES MAY BE MADE AT THE JUDGING TABLES other than those approved by the show secretary. Unapproved changes may result in your animal being disqualified by the secretary after the show. Once a show starts, no changes will be made to the paperwork. ARBA Show Rules, Section 23 … "No substitutions, changes, or additions will be allowed in a breed after judging of the breed has commenced. PLEASE CHECK ALL YOUR PAPERWORK before the show starts each sheet for each show! YOU are responsible for the information that is on the check-in sheets. If there is an error, either because the secretary typed it wrong or because you provided the information wrong, you must make the changes BEFORE the change deadline
- 14. Entry fees must be paid in full. Exhibitors are responsible for all exhibitor fees. If an animal is scratched from the show, exhibitors must pay for the scratched entry. Should you enter and not attend, you will be billed for your entry fees. Your mail, email or online entry is a contract and fees are payable regardless of your attendance. Exhibitors that do not come to the show will be sent a bill and will not be allowed to enter animals in future Georgia shows until the bill is paid. You enter, you owe.
- 15. No rabbits under 8 weeks of age will be allowed on the show premises.
- 16. Exhibitors are responsible for getting their rabbits to and from the judging tables. We will make 3 calls, from the judging table, for judging and then the rabbits on the table will be judged; rabbits not on the table will be passed over. Judging for Show B may start before Show a finishes. Please make sure you are listening for your breed so that you are not passed over for judging.
- 17. No sales of any rabbits or cavies will be allowed by anyone not showing rabbits or cavies. No animals are allowed on the property (building or fairgrounds) for sale, trade, transport, display, delivery, culls, or gift by anyone not showing rabbits or cavies. Visitors (anyone not entered in the show) may not carry rabbits/cavies/other animals around the building or fairgrounds or bring them into the building without prior permission. Any exhibitor wishing to sell anything other than rabbits or cavies must pay a vendor fee and must receive permission BEFORE the show. No product pre-sales or pre-orders or deliveries may be made at the show site without permission in the building or on the Fair grounds.
- 18. ARBA Show Rule

YOUTH SECTION 51. Youth may not enter their rabbit or cavy in both open and youth classes at the same show, which is sponsored by the same club. Youth may make entries in both open and youth classes with different animals.

This means that an animal may be shown in the Youth show(s) OR Open show(s) but not both. ANYONE may show in an Open show, regardless of age, but ONLY those exhibitors between the ages of 5 and 18 may show in the Youth shows – if an exhibitor is 4 years old, they must show in the Open show and if an exhibitor is 19 years old, they must show in the Open show.

- 19. YOUTH SHOW RULES are the SAME as for Open show.
- 20. Only current ARBA recognized breeds and varieties, or breeds and varieties with a current Certificate of Development will be allowed to be shown, as per ARBA rules. Please bring a copy of a working standard for the judges.
- 21. NO BALLOONS in the buildings!
- 22. Do not take pictures of animals or people without permission.
- 23. All Georgia state guidelines for RHDV apply. "Exhibition of rabbits does not require a CVI unless required by the individual show authority. Georgia requires an official CVI issued within the previous 30

days for rabbits entering for sale, trade, adoption, or exchange for a fee or other type of compensation" https://www.agr.georgia.gov/sites/default/files/documents/animal-health/rhdv-shows-and-exhibitionsguidance-gda.pdf

- 24. CAMPING SPOTS NO RESERVATIONS FIRST COME FIRST SERVED There are a LIMITED amount of hook ups on the Fairgrounds property. Some 50 amp, some 30 amp, some 110, no water, no dumping. Fee is \$15 per night. We cannot reserve spaces ahead of time. Contact Karin Humfleet, kjhumfleet@gmail.com, for info. You MUST be on the grounds, with your camper, receive a camping permit, checked in and paid with Karin Humfleet, no later than 6:30 pm Friday. And, there's no guarantee that there will be a spot available; this is a first come, first serve situation. The Fairgrounds will be upgrading their hook ups over the next year but so far, it's not enough for everyone to camp on site. If you are self-contained (no hook ups needed), you're welcome to park on the property for a fee of \$5.00 per night but you MUST check in, pay, and receive a camping permit from Karin Humfleet no later than 8:30 pm. The gate closes promptly at 9 pm NO latecomers.
- 25. Please note the following ARBA recommendations:
 - a) Exhibitors should follow ARBA recommended biosecurity guidelines.

b) Exhibitors and show officials should wash the undercarriage and tires of all vehicles and trailers before going to and after departing a show.

c) Exhibitors residing in a state with a confirmed case of RHDV in the past 30 days should have a health certificate (CVI) issued within fourteen (14) days of the show.

d) Use an appropriate disinfectant that will inactivate RHDV.

e) The ARBA club show committee has the right to refuse any entry for due cause.

f) The ARBA recommends carrying cages be cleaned prior to going to a show. The ARBA recommends the following products: kitty litter, newspaper, puppy pads, or other inert products used for bedding.

- g) State and county officials may impose additional stricter sanctions / requirements.
- h) Show officials can designate additional requirements to attend an ARBA sanctioned show.

i) If you are not comfortable with the provisions in (D), please continue to maintain biosecurity at your residence.

All buildings will be locked immediately after BIS judging Saturday evening. All exhibitors should plan to be out of the building quickly so show officials, judges, and exhibitors can attend their banquets and dinners with friends. The gate to the Fairgrounds will be closed at 9 pm on Saturday till 6 am Sunday

Exhibitors may leave their rabbits and cavies in the buildings but all animals in the Commercial Building 2 (main rabbit building) should be moved to the back end of the building, near the stage, to allow us to pull the club's equipment trailer into the front half. Front end of the building is the end closest to the fairgrounds entrance gate, back half of the building is the end facing the Fairgrounds back field. Angoras may stay in their "angora corner" but need to be away from the roll up door. This is in order for the show staff to bring one of our equipment trailers into the building to begin loading it.

Q1

Under the ADA, a service animal is defined as a dog that has been individually trained to do work or perform tasks for an individual with a disability. The task(s) performed by the dog must be directly related to the person's disability.

Q23

....However, if a particular service animal behaves in a way that poses a direct threat to the health or safety of others, has a history of such behavior, or is not under the control of the handler, that animal may be excluded.

Q27

The ADA requires that service animals be under the control of the handler at all times.....The service animal must be harnessed, leashed, or tethered while in public places unless these devices interfere with the service animal's work or the person's disability prevents use of these devices. may not allow the dog to wander away from her and must maintain control of the dog

This means that there will be no barking, whining, no signs of aggression (including low growling and baring teeth), no service dogs not under the DIRECT control of the handler, no disruptive behavior, etc. Your service dog must be leashed, harnessed, or tethered at all times and you must be in CONSTANT control of the leash.
