Entry due date/cost: Tuesday, March 10th by 11:00pm Central time - \$4.00 each rabbit, per show

**ANY ENTRIES RECEIVED AFTER 11:00PM CENTRAL TIME WILL BE CONSIDERED LATE, NO EXCEPTIONS**

Late entry deadline/cost: Wednesday, March 11th by 10:00pm Central time - \$5.00 each rabbit, per show

Fur entry date/cost: \$2.00 each rabbit, per show (deadlines above all apply)

**ENTRIES ARE NOT ACCEPTED ON THURSDAY OR FRIDAY, MUST ENTER THE DAY OF SHOW AT THE COST LISTED**

Day of show entries/cost: Saturday, March 14th from 6:30-7:30am Central time - \$6.00 each rabbit, per show

**ALL EXHIBITORS MUST BE CHECKED IN, ENTRIES VERIFIED AND ANY CHANGES MADE BY 7:30AM ON DAY OF SHOW**

Entry fees can be paid either on Friday evening from 5:00-8:00pm or Saturday morning from 6:30-7:30am

**Payment must be either by CASH or CHECK only (cash is preferred)**

**No debit/credit cards or electronic payments (PayPal, Venmo, Cash App, etc.) are accepted**

If paying by cash the exact amount owed is appreciated (to help speed up the check in process), but is not required.

If paying by check, it can only be accepted if written for the exact amount owed and dated for the day of show.

We cannot cash any checks, so please plan accordingly.

**THERE WILL BE NO REFUNDS ON ANY ENTRIES SUBMITTED THEN SCRATCHED ON DAY OF SHOW**

**ANY CHANGES EXCEPT FOR EAR NUMBERS ON SATURDAY WILL BE \$1.00 EACH, PER SHOW**

**NO CHANGES ARE ALLOWED AT THE JUDGING TABLE PER OFFICIAL ARBA SHOW RULES**

Attention all exhibitors, please read the following completely. If you are NOT going to be able to attend for ANY reason after sending your show entries, please contact the Show Secretary by PHONE at 931-212-0462 (NO EMAIL) before 7:30am Central time on the day of the show so we can plan accordingly. Any reasonable reasons for not being able to attend will be accepted without judgement, we understand that life happens. All we ask is that you please follow through by communicating that you will not be able to attend ASAP of knowing and before the deadline. **Our no show policy is a simple three strike rule, that is should you (#1) pre-enter, (#2) not attend and (#3) not contact the Show Secretary before 7:30am Central time by phone on the day of the show, you will be promptly billed for your entry fees plus any reasonable expenses incurred to inform and collect from you.** Anyone who has all three no show policy conditions met for this show will not be allowed to enter any additional ones in the future presented by the LCRBA until the amount due is paid in full. The LCRBA also has the right to require and only accept in person day of the show entries (at the cost listed for such) from the exhibitor for any future shows held regardless of their efforts to reconcile the debts owed and or personal history with the club. Starting at 5:00pm through 8:00pm Central time on Friday, March 13<sup>th</sup>

Onsite camping sites will not be available until 5:00pm Central time and must arrive by 8:00pm

The showroom will reopen at 6:30am on Saturday morning for any day of show check-in and exhibitor setups

**Please bring a tarp to place on the floor where your rabbits will be at, as always keep your area clean throughout the day to help us from having to start charging a cleanup fee to everyone in the future.**

## DIRECTIONS TO SHOW SITE

GPS address: 2030 Elkton Pike, Pulaski, TN 38478

From Interstate 65 take exit 14 onto Highway 64 (Fayetteville Highway) heading Westbound toward Pulaski for approximately 11 miles. At the intersection with Highway 31 turn left going Southbound for approximately 1.5 miles and the entrance to the show site is on the right.

## OFFICIAL SHOW RULES

### These are in addition to any stated above and or ARBA show guidelines –

1. This show will be governed by the official ARBA show rules and submission of any entry indicates acceptance of those rules.
2. All changes must go thru the Show Secretary prior to judging the breed. No changes are allowed at the judging table. Unauthorized changes/additions will be ignored during the after show paperwork.
3. Entry fees must be paid prior to the start of the show. After paying, there will be no refunds on entries given.
4. Check in will be from 6:30-7:30am Central time on day of show.
5. This is a no judging remark card show.
6. The Show Superintendent reserves the right to refuse any entry.
7. The Show Superintendent determines the judging order and reserves the right to reassign a judge as needed.
8. All carrying cages must be leak proof.
9. All rabbits must have a permanent and legible tattoo in the left ear in order to be entered into show.
10. Only exhibitors entered in the show can sell rabbits in the showroom. Rabbits entered in the show and then sold must be shown in the name originally entered, or scratched.
11. Youth exhibitors are responsible for getting their entries to the appropriate table.
12. The Show Secretary has the right to refuse any entries from all locations within 150 miles of a confirmed outbreak of RCD/RHD/VHD within 60 days of the entry deadline.
13. Parents are responsible for the actions of their children and for any damage done by them.
14. All reasonable care will be taken to provide a safe show; however, each exhibitor is ultimately responsible for all personal property to include their animals.
