SHOW RULES

- This show will be governed by the latest revised rules of the ARBA. Filing of entry indicates your acceptance of these show rules and those listed below.
- 2. The Illinois Rabbit Breeders Association will not be responsible for accidents; this includes but is not limited to loss in case of fire, theft or providential destruction. However, every precaution will be taken to prevent same.
- Cash, a good check or a money order are acceptable methods of payment for your entry. (There will be a \$25.00 service fee charge on all returned checks). Make all checks payable to the Illinois Rabbit Breeders Association (IRBA). The IRBA reserves the right to reject ANY entry for due cause.
- 4. All entered animals must be permanently and legibly earmarked.
- Day of show entry forms and remark cards are to be filled out completely and legibly by the exhibitor. Please check and double check your entry form against your remark cards. An animal at the table that does not appear on your entry form will be scratched.
- 6. Fur class entries are to be noted on your entry sheet, and must also be on a separate remark card for day of show entries.
- Fur classes will be provided for: Breed Fur/Normal White Fur & Wool/Normal Colored Fur & Wool. Unless otherwise
 noted on the entry form, all fur class animals will be entered in Breed Fur.
- 8. Open & Youth Judging will begin as close to 9:00 a.m. as possible on Saturday and Sunday. The IRBA reserves the right to substitute, add or remove judges as deemed necessary.
- 9. Other than official show personnel, Youth MUST carry youth entered animals.
- 10. There will be no placement ribbons given.
- 11. All sweepstakes will be governed by the latest rules. (IRBA show exhibitors who are current members of the IRBA will receive credit for double sweepstakes points earned, only towards the IRBA Sweepstakes).
- 12. Any/All animals exhibiting signs of sickness will be removed from the showroom, or otherwise isolated at the show official's discretion.
- 13. There must be ten (10) or more animals shown in the breed sweepstakes in order to warrant required specials by specialty clubs. The IRBA is not responsible for any donated awards.
- 14. Specialty Club shows will be held as prearranged between the specialty show host and the IRBA Show Superintendent. Contact the specialty show secretary for information regarding that breed specialty show.
- 15. If deemed necessary, the sponsoring club reserves the right to ask for proof of ownership for animals entered.
- 16. Unless otherwise specified within the catalog, any breeds NOT SANCTIONED will receive awards for BOB and BOS provided ten (10) or more animals are shown in the breed
- 17. Parents and/or guardians will be held responsible for their own actions as well as those of their own children and/or those children that accompanied them.
- There will be no smoking inside the show building, and no alcoholic beverages are allowed anywhere on the Interstate property.

YOUTH

Illinois Youth Guidelines

- All youth contests will be held at the Spring Illinois State Show. All efforts will be made to have royalty, showmanship, judging and breed ID contests.
- To participate in these contests, a youth must be a member of the IRBA, reside in the state of Illinois and must participate in the proper age category the day of the contest.
- Contest age breakdowns will be as follows: King and Queen-15-18. Duke and Duchess-12-14. Prince and Princess-9-11. Lord and Lady-5-8. Judging-Junior 12-14, Senior 15-18. Breed ID-Junior 5-11, Intermediate-12-14, Senior 15-18. Showmanship-9-11.
- Contest rules- No entry fee. Pre-entry desired but day of contest entry is allowed. Royalty will involve a written test. Tests can be read to any youth that needs assistance. The youth committee will provide writers for entrants that need help with writing their answers for breed ID. AR-BA youth standards and scoring will be used for all contests.
- All attempts will be made to form teams for the ARBA National Convention. If there is a larger number of participants than there are spots on the team, scores from the contests will be used to determine who will be on Team Illinois. Any other participants can possibly still compete as members of a District 5 team if the district forms a team.
- No parents will be allowed in the area of the royalty test or the breed id while their child is participating. This rule will be strictly enforced.

Illinois Youth Convention Funds

- Funds will be provided to all team members attending the convention as long as funds are available. Funds will be allocated as no more than \$250.00 per participant.
- To receive funds, participant or parent must do the following: assist with fundraising by either baking items for baked goods sale or working at the table during the raffle. Failure to help with any fundraising will forfeit the stipend even if the person is on the team. Participants and/or parents must also assist in some way with any benefit shows that are held for the youth fund. Some of the ways to help will be assisting with running the show, raffle, writing for judges, helping check in, helping set up or tear down.

Funds will be provided to the participant after the contests have concluded at the convention.

We will not have a raffle at the state convention this year, but we ask that you bring items for the regular raffle and assist with that or selling 50/50 tickets to be eligible to receive the funds for convention.
