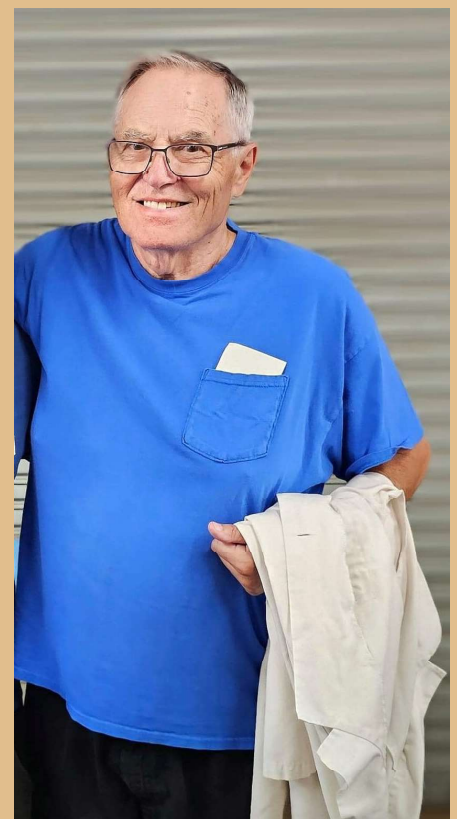

Too many to list but here are a handful of those breeds; New Zealands, Belgian Hares, Polish, English Spots, Havanas, Rhinelanders, Thriantas, and Mini Lops. In 2023, she achieved two significant milestones with English Lops at the ARBA'S 100th Convention in Louisville, KY. She successfully passed the Otter Variety English Lop Certificate of Development (COD) and won Best of Breed English Lop at that same ARBA Convention. As a newly licensed judge she has had the honor of judging Open Netherland Dwarfs at the 2024 ARBA Convention and Youth Netherland Dwarfs at the 2025 ARBA Convention. And is looking forward to her first Breed National show judging assignment this Spring. She truly values the friendships, mentorship, and shared passion that make the rabbit community unique and always looks forward to evaluating the outstanding animals exhibitors bring to her table.

Valerie started with silkies in 1973. She had bought a herd from someone advertised as Peruvians. She didn't realize she had silkies until she showed a photo of her silkies to Norma Johnson, she told Valerie that they were culls that are called silkies. That's what got her started to get them recognized. Unfortunately no one told Valerie she had to register to be counted as one of the silkie founders. She did however write the original standard for the silkies that was submitted and used in the ARBA standard until 1993. During the time she was taking her silkies to shows, she bought her first real Peruvian from a Canadian judge, Joan Gambioli, in 1974. His name was King Arthur and her first grand champion Peruvian in 1975. She has raised many other breeds but really loved a good Silkie or a Peruvian. She earned ARBA master breeder & exhibitor 2024. Valerie has been a judge since 2001. She really enjoys judging as well as showing her cavies.
