



HOW TO ENTER A RABBIT SHOW

& OTHER GENERAL INFORMATION

- There are a total of 6 shows that will take place during this weekend.
- Triple Open & Triple Youth means that there are three open all breed shows and three youth shows on Saturday. Saturday shows (Shows A, B & C) run concurrently; this means that a breed in Show B may be judged before Show A begins!
- The same rabbit cannot enter in both the open and corresponding youth show. IE a rabbit cannot enter in Open A & Youth A.
- All rabbits entered in the youth shows must be put on the judging table by a youth.
- **Pre-entry** means that all entries must be submitted prior to the pre-entry deadline (5/27/25) via time2enter.net
- After you submit your entries, a check in sheet will automatically be generated and sent to the email on file.

Review the check-in sheet for accuracy - make changes within Easy2Show before entry deadline as needed!

HOW TO ENTER A RABBIT SHOW

& OTHER GENERAL INFORMATION

Before the Show:

- Review your check in sheet for accuracy, change any information within the Easy2Show system before 5/27/25.
- If necessary: Tattoo any rabbit(s) with a permanent, legible mark matching the tattoo submitted on your show entry.
- Trim all rabbit nails- our judges thank you!!
- Brush or pluck out any loose fur with a brush
- Prep all show supplies and carriers so they are clean and ready for the show.

The Day of the Show:

- Plan to arrive by 8:00 AM, at least 30 minutes before the show begins.
- Check-in is not required provided your entries are paid and you do not have any general questions.
- Exhibitors can setup carriers and chairs anywhere within the rented facility. Please be cognizant of others space requirements and walking lanes.
- Breed judging order will be posted behind the judging tables for exhibitor convenience and planning.
- Breeds will be announced by show staff to begin loading at the judging tables.

After the Show:

• Exhibitor reports will be emailed within 30 days of the show.

HOW TO ENTER A RABBIT SHOW

& OTHER GENERAL INFORMATION

Set yourself up for success by answering these questions for each rabbit you wish to show before submitting your entry.

- Identify the breed of the rabbit. Only ARBA accepted breeds (or breeds with a certificate of development issued by ARBA) may show at an ARBA all breed show
- Identify the sex/gender of the rabbit.
- Identify the age category the rabbit will be on show day?
 - Smaller breeds (known as 4 Class breeds) show as:
 - Juniors (Under 6 months of age)
 - Seniors (Over 6 months of age)
 - Larger breeds (known as 6 Class breeds) show as:
 - Juniors (Under 6 months of age)
 - Intermediates (6 8 months of age)
 - Seniors (Over 8 months of age)
- Weigh the rabbit and use the ARBA SOP to verify that the weight is appropriate for the breeds age category you wish to enter.

 • Some breeds allow you to show up in age if maximum weight is

exceeded for juniors and intermediates.

IE: A 7 month old, 10.5lb Silver Fox buck is an intermediate by age, BUT the ARBA SOP states that the maximum intermediate buck weight is 10lbs. The Silver Fox breed SOP allows animals to show up in age. Therefore, this buck needs to show in the senior age category in order to avoid being DO'd.

 Identify the variety of the rabbit and use the ARBA SOP to determine the show class variety. All breeds are unique in their show class varieties.

IE: a Mini Rex has over twenty different varieties classes they could be entered as, however Holland Lops only exhibit under two variety classes: broken and solid. Check the ARBA SOP to verify varieties!

- Identify the tattooed numbers & letters in the left ear.
 - Standards for tattoos are simple: a personally unique combination of numbers and letters (special characters are not allowed), between 1-30 digits in length, no profanity or vulgarity permitted.

IE: The tattoos 'A' and 'ILOVESHOWINGRABBITS' are equally acceptable.

However the tattoo 'I @M \$uch @ rebel! :-) 'must be disqualified.



- 1. This is an ARBA Sanctioned Show, by the filing of your entry you indicate your acceptance of all RMHS show rules and the rules of ARBA, which govern this show (sec.4546 exhibitors' rules of ARBA).
- 2. This is a Rocky Mountain High Shows Inc. sanctioned show, by the filing of your entry you indicate your acceptance of all RMHS show rules.

3. ENTRY:

This is a **one-day event, RMHS will host three OPEN shows** and three YOUTH shows.

All entry forms MUST be completely filled out (Name, complete mailing address, and phone). Easy2Show online entries will be accepted until **5/27/25**.

Submission of an entry form indicates an agreement to pay all entry fees whether you show or not.

DAY OF SHOW ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.

4. All animals showing signs of disease shall be removed from the event. This will be enforced by RMHS officials. Entries in subsequent shows for that animal and exhibitor, for that day, will be forfeited.

- 5.There will be a \$50.00 service charge for all returned checks. Any returned checks will be cause for denied access to future RMHS shows without prepayment.
- 6. There are to be no rabbits in the showroom under the age of 8 weeks for sale or for free. NO EXCEPTIONS.
- 7. All rabbits must have a PERMANENT, LEGIBLE EAR MARK in the LEFT ear, or they will be eliminated from the competition.
- 8. Exhibitors must adhere to all posted signage.
- 9. Youth Exhibitors may enter Youth Shows through the age of 19 years. Adults cannot show in Youth Shows. Youth may show in Opens Shows, but may not enter the same rabbit in both Open and Youth Classes in the same show. Youth may enter both Open and Youth classes with different animals. YOUTH RABBITS MUST BE PUT ON THE TABLE BY A YOUTH A YOUTH DOES NOT HAVE TO CARRY HIS/HER OWN RABBIT.
- 10. Substitutions and corrections will be accepted until 5/27/25. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to verify entries for accuracy and make changes within the Easy2Show portal before the change deadline. Generally, changes received after the deadline but BEFORE THE SHOW will be accepted if the exhibitor follows the Change Process detailed on page 8. The show committee reserves the right to make changes if extenuating circumstances are present.

- 11. Exhibitors will be responsible for getting their rabbits to the judging tables as soon as the class is called. Rabbits will be called two (2) times, if not on the table after the final call the class will be closed. NO REJUDGING OF A CLASS
- 12. All rights reserved to substitute judges in any event. The Show Superintendent or Secretary reserves the right to make any changes deemed necessary. The Judging order will be posted the day of the show.
- 13. The decisions of the judges will be final. Exhibitors must act in a professional manner towards judges, show committee, show help (writers) and each other. This is expected of both adults and youth. Exhibitors attempting to or interfering with, annoying or trying to influence a judge, or behaving in an unbecoming manner will be rejected and barred from the show, forfeiting all entry fees.
- 14. In accordance with ARBA Rules Section 15-D2, please note the following recommendations:
 - Exhibitors should follow ARBA recommended biosecurity guidelines.
 - Exhibitors and show officials should wash the undercarriage and tires of all vehicles and trailers before going to and after departing a show.
 - Exhibitors residing in a state with a confirmed case of RHDV in the past 30 days should have a health certificate (CVI) issued within fourteen (14) days of the show.
 - Use an appropriate disinfectant that will inactivate RHDV.
 - The ARBA club show committee has the right to refuse any entry for due cause.
 - The ARBA recommends carrying cages be cleaned prior to going to a show. The ARBA recommends the following products: kitty litter, newspaper, puppy pads, or other inert products used for bedding.

- 15. All equipment, clothing and vehicles brought to the event must be thoroughly cleaned and sanitized. This includes carriers, grooming equipment, dollies, vehicle under carriages, shoes, etc. Anything that has been in contact with the ground or exposed to insects/rodent vectors may carry RHDV2. Be cognizant of that and clean and sanitize appropriately.
- 16. Absolutely no smoking will be allowed in the showroom. You must smoke outside and at least 15 feet from any doorway when smoking per Colorado state laws. This will be enforced.
- 17. Rocky Mountain Hight Shows, or the owner, agent, organization or the show facility, or any other related organization will NOT BE HELD RESPONSIBLE for any type of loss or injury due to fire, accident, or providential destruction under any circumstances to any person, animal, or personal property, whether owned, borrowed, or rented. Every precaution will be taken to prevent any accident from happening.
- 18. The show committee will not accept entries without an ARBA official working standard pursuant to ARBA show 28(b).
- 19. This is a carrier show. All carriers must have a leak proof bottom. Please keep your area clean during the show and clean your area before leaving.

20. RMHS RESERVES THE RIGHT TO REMOVE ANY PERSON OR PERSONS DEEMED A PROBLEM. PLEASE KEEP CONTROL OF MINORS IN YOUR CHARGE.

- 21. Exhibitors must act in a professional, safe manner both in the showroom and outside the showroom. This is expected of adults AND youth. Absolutely NO interference with judges or judging will be tolerated. ARBA provides specific guidelines for protests. Any emergencies or concerns/complaints should be immediately reported to Show Officials. Show Committee decisions will be final.
- 22. By submitting your entries you agree to the following statements:
- I acknowledge the contagious nature of the Coronavirus/COVID-19 and that the CDC and many other public health authorities still recommend practicing social distancing.
- I acknowledge the contagious nature of Rabbit Hemorrhagic Disease virus 2/(RHDV2) and that the state vet of Colorado recommends practicing self-quarantining.
- I further acknowledge that CARS volunteers cannot guarantee that I, or my rabbits, will not become infected with the Coronavirus/COVID-19 or Rabbit Hemorrhagic Disease virus 2/(RHDV2) respectively.
