

All exhibitors will receive an invoice with their check-in sheets. You may pay online with the payment options or in person with cash, check, or card. Online will include credit card fees.

We do not accept entries over the phone, Facebook messages, text, comments on Facebook, etc.

It is your responsibility to ensure your entry forms are accurate. Email the secretary with errors needing correction. All corrections/changes must be made by 10/16/25 @ 10 AM EST.

Check in and Changes

- ★ Check in begins Friday at 4 PM EST. All Friday night entries must be paid prior to the start of the show at 6:30 PM.
- ★ Rabbits may be left in the showroom Friday night.
- ★ The showroom opens at 6:30 AM the morning of the Saturday show.
- **All changes must be completed by 10/16/25 @ 10 AM EST**
- ★ The Saturday show begins at 8:00 AM.

NO CHANGES WILL BE MADE AFTER THE POSTED DEADLINE-ANY UNAUTHORIZED CHANGES TO PAPERWORK WILL RESULT IN YOUR RABBIT BEING DISQUALIFIED - PLEASE FIND THE SHOW SECRETARY IF THERE IS AN ISSUE

Awards

Best of Breed and Best Opposite Sex of Breed awards will be present if there are 10 rabbits in Open or 5 rabbits in Youth. Awards must be picked up at the show. None will be mailed.

Best In Show Judging

Best in show rabbits will be chosen at the end of the day after the completion of all shows, to eliminate the possibility of unfairly influencing any judge that may be judging animals in the later shows. If you cannot stay for the conclusion of the last show, please arrange to leave your BOB animals with a friend for the BIS competitions.

SEBACS and ARBA Show Rules

- **1.** SEBACS shall be governed by the latest version of the ARBA rules. https://arba.net/official-arba-show-rules-2/
- **2.** By submitting animal entries to SEBACS, you agree to the rules of both the ARBA and SEBACS.
- ALL show entry fees must be paid before the start of the show even if you are unable to attend. (In case of emergency, please contact the show secretary immediately.)
 Failure to pay entry fees may result in denial of entries for future shows.
- **4.** At no time shall entry fees be refunded even in the event of incorrectly listed ear numbers, sex, variety, no-show, and DQ.
- **5.** It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to read check-in sheets and ensure accuracy. All errors must be corrected BEFORE the posted deadline.
- Habitual violation of show rules will result in denial of entries for future shows.
- **7.** Show age groups will be Open and Youth per the ARBA rules.
- **8.** All youth entries must be carried to the show table by a youth.
- **9.** Open exhibitors do not have to carry their own animals to the show table.
- **10.** Animals may be entered in either Open or Youth, but not both.
- **11.** Each breed will be called for 3 times. If your rabbits are not on the table shortly after the third call, the judging will proceed. Entry refunds will not be issued for animals that do not make it to the table in time for judging.
- **12.** Best in Show judging will be announced before starting. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to bring their Best of Breed winners to the table when called.
- **13.** All show participants are expected to act in a professional, courteous, and kind manner for the duration of the show. Harassment, interfering with judging, writing, secretary work, or behaving poorly/inappropriately by you and/or your children will not be tolerated and will result in your expulsion from the show and forfeiture of all entries and fees.
- **14.** Children are the responsibility of the parents or quardians, not the show committee.

- If you or your child break or cause damage to something belonging to someone else, the show, or the venue, you will be responsible to pay for or replace that item.
- Running and horseplay are not allowed at the show.
- Do not sit on tables. Sit only in designated areas.
- **15.** If your children are misbehaving and you are unable or unwilling to correct their behavior, you may be expelled from the show. In the event of your expulsion, you and your children must vacate the premises immediately. All entries will be scratched. You will receive no more than 2 warnings before you are expelled from the show.
- **16.** Only rabbits, cavies, and service dogs are allowed in the showroom. No service dogs in training, no pet dogs, no cats, no pigs, no birds, snakes, or other animals.
- **17.** Per ARBA rules, any animals exhibiting signs of illness will be quarantined and/or removed from the venue.
 - Rabbits disqualified for illnesses will not be allowed to exhibit in the subsequent shows.
- **18.** All carriers must have a solid leak-proof base.
- **19.** You are expected to keep your area clean.
- **20.** Do not throw trash, paper towels, etc. on the floor. Trash bins will be available, please use them.
- **21.** Cage bedding, wool, etc... must be cleaned up before exhibitors leave. Leaving litter inside or outside the building may result in being banned from future shows.
- 22. All individuals vending or selling items must be pre-approved before the show.
- 23. Selling rabbits and cavies is allowed as long as:
 - 1. The animals are at least 8 weeks of age.
 - 2. You have entered animals into the show.
 - 3. You have notified SEBACS of your intent to sell.
- **24.** The show officials will select judges, the judging order, and have the right to change judges and judging order as necessary.
- **25.** The consumption of alcoholic beverages is not permitted in the showroom or on the show premises.
- **26.** Smoking is only permitted in designated areas. All litter, including butts, must be disposed of appropriately and should not be thrown on the ground.

- **27.** Awards will be given per ARBA guidelines. All awards must be collected before the conclusion of the show. Awards will not be mailed.
- 28. The Exhibitor shall save, defend, hold harmless, and indemnify SEBACS from and against any and all losses, damages, liabilities, claims, and costs of whatsoever kind and nature for injury to or death of any person or animal and for loss of or damage to any property occurring in connection with or in any way related to SEBACS, its shows, its employees or agents.

ARBA REQUIRED RULES:

SECTION 15. A show catalog must be furnished to any person upon request. The show catalog must be furnished to all hired judges and registrars at least 14 days prior to the show date. The show catalog must contain the club name, show date, show location, entry deadline, time judging will start, the name and address of the show secretary and show superintendent, and any required specialty club information. The catalog should supply as much information as possible and must be available at least 14 days prior to the show date. The following must be printed in the show catalog:

- (A) Open Sanctioned Show OFFICIAL ARBA SANCTIONED SHOW, ARBA Executive Director, PO Box 400, Knox, PA 16232-0400. ARBA website: www.arba.net. Membership Dues: \$20.00 per yr., 3 yrs. \$50.00. Combination Husband & Wife: \$30.00 per yr., 3 yrs. \$75.00.
- (B) Youth Sanctioned Show OFFICIAL ARBA YOUTH SANCTIONED SHOW, ARBA Executive Director, PO Box 400, Knox, PA 16232-0400. ARBA website: www.arba.net. Membership Dues: \$12.00 per yr., 3 yrs. \$30.00.
- (C) Announcement of the date and place of the next ARBA Convention and Annual Meeting.
- (D):1- Action taken by the ARBA Board will be evaluated on a case-by-case basis depending on the circumstances noted and in accordance with the ARBA Constitution and By-Laws
- 2- Please note the following recommendations:
- a) Exhibitors should follow ARBA recommended biosecurity guidelines.
- b) Exhibitors and show officials should wash the undercarriage and tires of all vehicles and trailers before going to and after departing a show.
- c) Exhibitors residing in a state with a confirmed case of RHDV in the past 30 days should have a health certificate (CVI) issued within fourteen (14) days of the show.
- d) Use an appropriate disinfectant that will inactivate RHDV.
- e) The ARBA club show committee has the right to refuse any entry for due

cause.

- f) The ARBA recommends carrying cages be cleaned prior to going to a show. The ARBA recommends the following products: kitty litter, newspaper, puppy pads, or other inert products used for bedding.
- g) State and county officials may impose additional stricter sanctions / requirements.
- h) Show officials can designate additional requirements to attend an ARBA sanctioned show.
- i) If you are not comfortable with the provisions in 15.(D), please continue to maintain biosecurity at your residence.
- SECTION 16. The show sponsor may print the following in their show catalog: All youth entries must be carried to the show table by a youth. Exhibitors do not have to carry their own animals to the show table.


