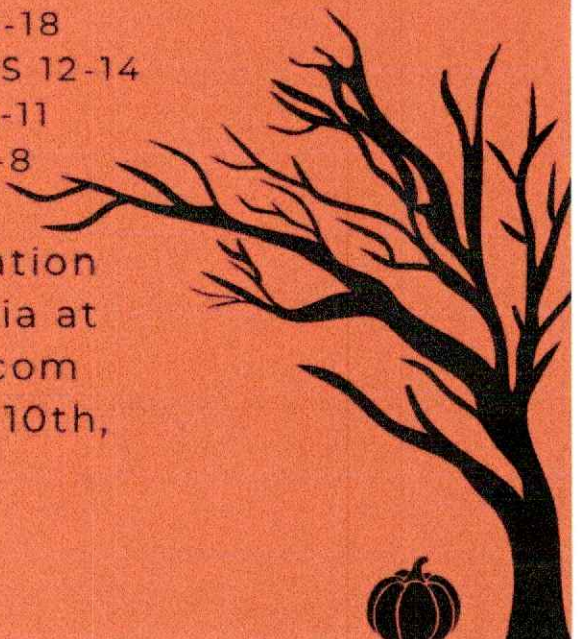

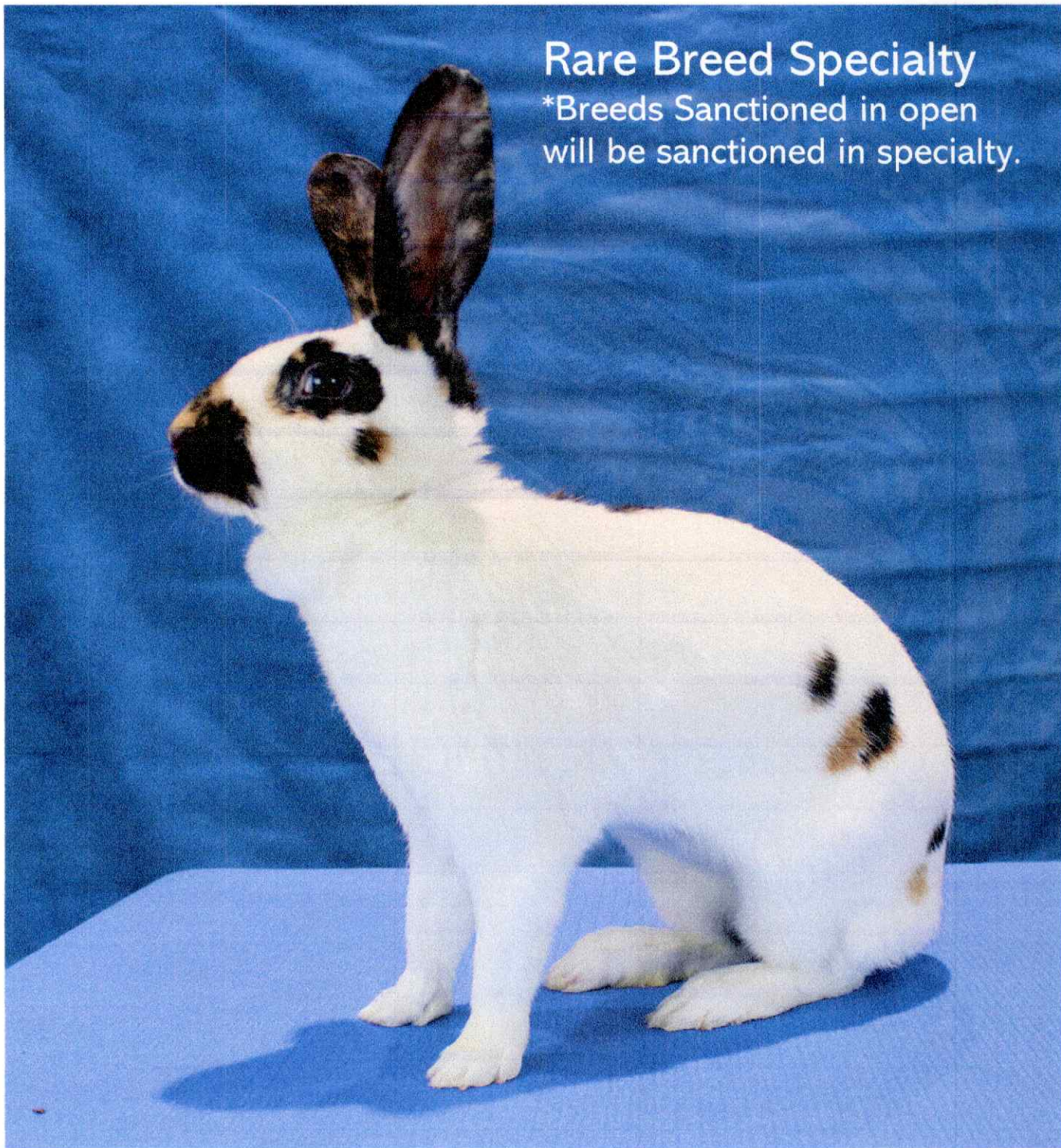

Official RRBA Show Rules:

1. All rabbits must be permanently and legibly tattooed. All rabbits must be inside the showroom by 8:30am.
2. Judging will begin at 9:00a.m. Please check in with the secretary and pay show fees before 8:30. Cash or check accepted. Checks are to be made out to Richmond RBA.
3. Exhibitors are responsible for ensuring their animals get to the judging tables; **Exhibitors showing in youth must table their own animals.**
4. All official ARBA show rules as of the date of each show will be in effect for these shows.
5. The show superintendent WILL remove any animal showing signs of illness. There will be no exceptions.
6. No refunds will be provided for scratched entries.
7. Returned checks will be subject to a \$50 charge to be paid prior to the exhibitor's show report being mailed. If the returned check is not made good in 30 days after notification by the show secretary, the exhibitor's entry will be removed from the show and amended reports will be sent to the appropriate national breed club secretaries.
8. There will be no changes to the show paperwork at the judges' table. ARBA will be notified of exhibitors caught tampering with the show paperwork. That entry will be disqualified.
9. Breeds with less than ten rabbits will NOT be sanctioned next year unless sponsored.
10. No animals other than rabbits or certified service animals are allowed into the showroom.
11. RRBA is not responsible for any loss due to fire, theft, flood, etc. All reasonable precautions will be taken to safeguard exhibitors and their animals.
12. **Woolled breeds** are to be groomed outside the showroom. No blowers or electric grooming equipment may be operated inside the showroom.
13. Substitutions made on the day of show must be ear number changes only and must be completed by 8:30 A.M., NO ear changes are allowed once the show has started. **DAY OF SHOW ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.**
14. Children are the responsibility of their parents – no screaming, shouting, or running is allowed in the showroom. Failure to control a child's behavior may be the basis for disqualification of an exhibitor's entire entry and forfeiture of all fees paid. Any property damage incurred will be the parents' responsibility.
15. RRBA reserves the right to add, cancel or substitute judges as necessary.
16. Best In Show and Reserve in Show will be chosen from all BOB winners in that show. It is the owner's responsibility to bring their BOB rabbits to the BIS judging table in a timely manner. If you plan to leave before BIS judging, please let the show secretary know that you are leaving.
17. This is a carrier cage show. All carriers are required to have leak proof pans.
18. Rabbits entered in fur classes must also be shown in regular breed classes.
19. **Chairs and grooming tables will only be allowed if space is available after all the carriers are in the showroom. Please stack your cages at least two high indoors to accommodate other exhibitors.**
20. IN THE CASE OF INCLEMENT WEATHER, THERE ARE NO REFUNDS IF OUR RABBIT SHOW IS NOT CANCELLED.
21. RRBA reserves the right to decline future entries if exhibitor has a history of entering and then failing to attend the show.
22. Awards will be given if the breed is sanctioned and there are at least 10 rabbits shown.
23. RRBA will not be responsible for any disease or sickness to humans or animals. It is the responsibility of exhibitors to make prudent choices regarding their health and the health of their animals. If you are uncomfortable with the surroundings, do not come. If you or your animals are experiencing illness (covid/RHD/other transmissible disease) or have had recent disease exposure (covid/RHD/other transmissible disease), do not come.
24. Open Exhibitors are eligible for the following awards/prizes BOV/BOSV, BG/BOSG, BOB/BOSB, and BIS/RIS.
25. Youth Exhibitors are eligible for the following awards/prizes 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th, 5th, BOV/BOSV, BG/BOSG, BOB/BOSB, BIS/RIS
26. Check-in sheets are emailed to you once your entry has been entered into the show program, if you do not receive a check-in sheet within 48 hours of sending your entry form, please contact the show secretary.
27. Please check your check-in sheets carefully for errors and contact the show secretary BEFORE the show to make those corrections, ONLY ear changes are allowed at check-in. We do NOT print out check-in sheets,

please print them for your records.

28. We are not responsible for errors **that were missed until the day of show, PLEASE REVIEW YOUR CHECK-IN SHEETS!**

29. The filing of an entry indicates acceptance of these rules.

Covid Rules:

- ARBA guidelines regarding RHD will be enforced- no entries will be accepted from any location within 50 miles of a confirmed outbreak within the past 30 days.
- Additionally, do not bring to the showgrounds any animal that has passed through any RHD area (50 miles from outbreak within the past 30 days).
- Va Dept. of Agriculture guidance recommends Certificates of veterinary inspection 3-5 days prior to entry at an event. They also recommend out-of-state participants check with their state animal health officials prior to leaving for the event to determine the requirements for the return of rabbits to their home state after the event. While we will be adhering as closely as we can to the guidelines of VADCS and recommend obtaining a CVI, we will not be checking them at the show.
- Va State Covid guidelines current information can be found here: <https://www.virginia.gov/coronavirus/>
- No one with a fever or symptoms of COVID19, a positive diagnostic test for the virus that causes COVID-19 in the prior 10 days or known exposure to a COVID-19 case in the prior 14 days, is permitted on the grounds.
- By entering the showgrounds the day of the show, you attest that you and all persons riding with you are not currently experiencing fever (100.4°F or higher) or a sense of having a fever, a new cough that cannot be attributed to another health condition, new shortness of breath that cannot be attributed to another health condition, new chills that cannot be attributed to another health condition, a new sore throat that cannot be attributed to another health condition, or new muscle aches that cannot be attributed to another health condition or specific activity (such as physical exercise).
