SHOW RULES

1. This show is to be governed by the latest rules of the ARBA, and filing an entry indicates acceptance of the same.

2. The River Valley Rabbit Club will not be responsible for loss from Fire, Theft, Accidents, or Providential Destruction. Every precaution will be taken to prevent the same.

3. Sanctions received too late for listing will be posted in the showroom.

4. The club reserves the right to substitute and add judges.

5. ENTRY FEE: Single rabbit/cavy - \$3.00. Fur/wool entries \$1.50. (OPEN & YOUTH) Youth receive discounted fee of \$1.50 per rabbit up to 5, then regular \$3.00 per head fee applies for 6+ rabbits.

6. Fur entries must be shown it regular breed class, and not disqualified. They will be shown in their BREED class.

7. This will be a carrier show only. All carriers must have a solid bottomed.

8. ALL stock must be permanently and legibly tattooed or tagged in the left ear.

9. Any animal showing signs of sickness or disease will be denied show space or asked to leave at the discretion of the Show Superintendent or Show Secretary. Entry fees will not be refunded.

10. Rabbits shown in the Youth show must be carried and placed on the table by youth.

11. You are responsible for getting your rabbits to the judges table. Classes will be called from the secretary table. No entry fees will be refunded.

12. Ribbons for 1st, 2nd and 3rd place as well as Best of Breed and Best Opposite Sex will be available at the show. No ribbons will be mailed.

13. An ARBA registrar will be available.

14. ARBA entry forms and remark cards or computer software forms will be accepted. A breed must have had ten (10) animals shown last year to be sanctioned. If you wish to sponsor a sanction for any breed, contact the Show Secretary.

15. No breeding is allowed on the premises without consent of the owner/owners and Show Superintendent or Show Secretary.

16. All vendors selling items must be approved by TRVRC prior to setting up in the showroom and t a donation to the raffle is requested.

17. The ARBA host club reserves the right to refuse entries from all locations within 150 miles which has a confirmed outbreak of RCD/RHD/ VHD within the past 60 days of the entry deadline.

18. The host club is not responsible for catalog errors or omissions.

19. You are responsible for you and your children while visiting the St. Joseph Valley Fairgrounds; therefore, if you or your child damage property; you are responsible for its repair or replacement.
