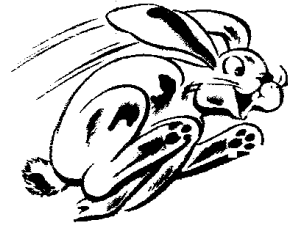

Sanctioned Breeds: Mini Rex (O), Rex (O&Y)

Breeds will be sanctioned by donation only, but the cost of sanctions will be refunded if 25 or more are shown in the breed. Contact Chris Swartout by September 1st to sanction a breed. You may still show even if your breed is not sanctioned.

Breeder's Choice: Exhibitors may enter rabbits that were bred and raised by the exhibitor. \$5 per entry will be collected at the show with 50% of the pot going to the top three winners. Sign-up at the show.

Awards: Awards will be provided to sanctioned breeds or those with 25 or more in the breed. 1st through 3rd place ribbons will be offered to youth only.

Raffle: There will be a raffle table as well as a 50/50 raffle. Donations are welcome and appreciated.

Youth Events: There will be a showmanship competition with a special demonstration before. More details will be made available at the show.

Show Rules

1. The show is governed by the latest ARBA Rules.
2. No smoking is allowed in the showroom.
3. The CNDRB is not responsible for loss in the event of fire, theft, or vandalism, nor is it responsible for exposure to COVID-19 or RHDV2. Attendees participate at their own risk.
4. Exhibitors may not attend an ARBA sanctioned show if they live within 150 miles of an active RHDV2 outbreak, even if their rabbits have been vaccinated. This is due to the risk of spreading the virus if travelling by automobile through an outbreak area. The restriction is maintained for 60 days from the date of the last confirmed infection in that area.
5. Rabbits that are disqualified in one show due to contagious illness, such as those displaying white nasal discharge or vent disease, will be automatically scratched from subsequent shows and must be removed from the showroom. No refunds will be provided.
6. No entry changes or corrections will be made at the show. No exceptions.
7. All youth entries must be put on the table by youth exhibitors.
8. Any changes made at the table will be null and void. If the entry is not the same as what was originally entered, it does not exist. There will be no refunds and no awards received. Any award received must be returned.
9. Once entries have been submitted, exhibitors are required to pay entry fees. No refunds shall be given.
10. Best in Show selection will take place at the conclusion of the day. Please plan accordingly.
11. Parents & guardians will be responsible for their children and any damage they may cause.
12. CNDRB reserves the right to substitute or secure additional judges and/or registrars. The CNDRB also reserves the right to cancel the show due to safety concerns.
13. Rabbits must be permanently tattooed in the left ear. Illegible or missing tattoos will be disqualified.
14. All exhibitors are responsible for getting their rabbits to the show table when the breed is called.
15. Exhibitors are responsible for keeping their area neat and tidy, and walkways free of obstruction. Exhibitors are also responsible for cleaning up their space at the end of show.
16. No animals other than rabbits/cavies are allowed in showroom except seeing eye companions.
17. Returned check will be charged \$25. Winnings, points and future privileges to show will depend on restitution.
18. Any rabbit entered in fur must be entered in regular class.
19. Any decision made by the show superintendent is final.
