Show Information

Harassment of judges will **not be tolerated**. Harassing judges will result in exhibitor entries being scratched without refund, exhibitor forfeiture of fees, points, legs, & awards, and exhibitor may be asked to leave the show grounds.

There are no specialties at this time.

How to Enter:

The TRBA State Show is a **pre-entry preferred, day-of-show entry allowed, no-comment card, carry cage show**. Pre-entries are \$5/head/show for Friday and Sunday shows and \$7/head for Saturday prior to March 9, 2026 at 10pm Central. After that time, the **late** rate increases to \$7/head/show for Friday and Sunday; \$9/head/show Saturday. Fur is \$2/head/show pre-entry and \$3/head/show late entry. You may enter any show you desire; you are not obligated to enter all shows.

The time frame for free **changes** is from **March 9 at 10pm Central until Monday, March 16, 2025 at 10pm**. Added Entries received during this time frame will be added at the *Late entry rate*. Changes after the pre-entry cutoff and Day-of-show changes are \$2/change and are limited to single changes on the entry (IE: tattoo or variety or class, NOT tattoo and variety); otherwise

that change would be considered a scratch and a new entry. So – if you entered #ERT Mini Satin Broken Sr. Buck and you decided to change to #BEY Mini Satin Tort Sr. Buck, it is a new entry. The fee would be deleted for ERT, and the entry for BEY would be added as a day-of-show; the difference in fees is \$2/show. But, if your change is a single adjustment (like you discover that ERT is in fact a doe), the change is \$2/show. Of course, any change due to secretary error during the data entry process is free to correct but the correction **must be completed prior to or during check in.**

Entries can be emailed to texasrabbitbreeders@gmail.com for all shows. **After your entry is processed, you will receive an invoice from Square; the entry is not complete until the fee is paid.** The Facebook event page is kept as up to date as possible.

Fees are due upon receipt of invoice. Texas RBA accepts cash and credit/debit cards at check in for late entries and changes.

If you fail to attend the show after submitting entries, you will be liable for entry fees as we hire judges based upon expected entry numbers.

Extenuating circumstances are considered – please notify show staff if you must cancel.

Banquet

Banquet Tickets are \$25/adult and \$20/child **Under age 10**. Banquet ticket request must be submitted by the entry deadline with a complete head count. For Example: Smith family needs 3 adult and 2 child tickets. (Teens and Preteens count as adults). The menu is beef/chicken taco bar with dessert. **When you submit your ticket request, please indicate adult/youth and**

beef/chicken for each ticket. You will be sent an invoice with your entries with an itemized line for Banquet Tickets. Payment for the banquet tickets must also be completed by March 11. If you do not plan to exhibit, but do plan to attend the banquet, the ticket deadline remains the same.

Applicant must be a current youth member of Texas Rabbit Breeders Association and attend the TRBA State Convention.

CONTESTS

The following contests are the Saturday of the TRBA State Show in Belton. Applicants can choose to enter Royalty or any combination of Individual Contests available for their age division. Awards provided to the top three for each contest in each age division. There is one royalty winner for each division. There is no cost to participate. However, all contestants must register by the appropriate deadlines. Royalty has an earlier deadline to allow time to score the applications.

Breed Identification (All ages)

Contestants will identify a number of animals, both rabbits and cavies, listing the complete breed name as printed in the ARBA Standard of Perfection, the showroom variety, whether a 4-class or 6-class breed, and the registration variety of each animal. The ARBA Official Breed ID Guide (found on ARBA website) is used to score.

Written Test (All ages)

Examination questions will be drawn from the ARBA Official Guidebook to Raising Better Rabbits and Cavies, the ARBA Yearbook, ARBA Standard of Perfection, current issues of the Domestic Rabbit magazine and current issues of the TRBA News. Questions are in multiple choice, true/false, matching, and short-answer formats.

Quiz Bowl (Pre-Jr & Juniors)

Contestants will participate in a Jeopardy-type competition, demonstrating their rabbit and cavy knowledge.

Showmanship (Rabbit - Pre-Jr & Juniors, Cavy - All ages)

Contestants will examine and evaluate an animal, telling the judge what they are doing and why as they go along. The ARBA showmanship scorecard will be used.

Judging (Intermediate & Seniors)

Contestant will place two classes of four animals per class. This may include breeding rabbits, market classes, or cavies.

Royalty (All ages)

Composite score of application and all age-appropriate contests.

Size & Scope of Project (36 points)

1. When did you join the TRBA, and how many consecutive years have you belonged?
2. Explain how and why you got started in your project. Include the year, breeds and who helped you.
3. Name the breed(s) you raise & how many animals you have in each breed. Explain why you chose each breed. Also include breed(s) you have raised in the past & why you no longer raise them.
4. List your membership in rabbit and/or cavy-related organizations. Include the name of club & number of years you have been a member.

Leadership (36 points)

5. What offices have you held or committees have you served on in local, state or national rabbit or cavy clubs?
6. How have you been a leader in your project?
7. What have you done to promote your breed(s) and make others aware of your project?
8. Give 2-3 examples where you've personally helped another exhibitor at a show or rabbit/cavy event. Describe the circumstance and what you learned in the process.

Management (36 points)

9. Describe your housing and equipment. Be specific.
10. What specifically do you do to help with the care and upkeep of your project?
11. Describe the records you keep and how you keep them.
12. Do you register your rabbits? Why or why not?

Achievement (36 points)

13. Make a table or a list of outstanding awards and achievements your animals have earned since April 1, 2025. Pick two from your list and explain why they are important to you.
14. Make a table or a list of outstanding awards and achievements you have earned in this project since April 1, 2025. Pick two from your list and explain why they are important to you.

Purpose, Goals, & Plans for the Future (36 points)

15. What are your goals for this project? What are your personal goals? What goals have you achieved to this point?
16. What are some setbacks or struggles that you have faced within your project(s) or goals? What have you done to overcome those setbacks? Do you plan to make any changes in your project to achieve your goals?
17. How do you feel your project will help you in your future endeavors?
18. What would you like for us to know that has not been asked?

Clarity, Completeness & Neatness (20 points)

10-12-pt reader-friendly font

Name on each page

Answered all questions

Scoring

Each of the 5 question components will be scored with a maximum of 36 total points. Clarity, Completeness, & Neatness will be 20 total points. Maximum of 200 points earned (100 per grader).

The application score will be added with scores from written test, breed identification and showmanship/judging. The highest overall total will be the royalty winner for the division.

RULES & LIABILITY

Only current TRBA members that are Texas residents are eligible to compete. The Royalty contest is a combination of application, written test, breed identification, and showmanship (Ages 5-11) or hands-on judging (Ages 12+). An application is required to be submitted by the deadline to be eligible to compete in royalty. **All other contest elements will be completed at the TRBA State Show in Belton, Texas on Saturday March 21, 2026.**

1. Applications are to be composed and completed by the contestant. They should be typed and include your name on each page.
2. Respond to the following questions on your own paper (8.5x11inches) in seven pages or less, excluding this cover page.
3. Include one photo attachment of yourself. Omission will receive a deduction.
4. This cover page and application must be filled out completely, including the necessary signatures, to be accepted.

Submission of this application releases liability and provides consent to TRBA Youth Committee to use the information and photographs provided. We agree requirements have been met and this application is accurately completed to the best of our knowledge.

Make Plans to attend the ARBA 103rd National Convention in Reno,NV on October 22-28, 2026!

Texas RBA Show Rules

1. This show will be governed by the latest ARBA rules.
2. Animal entry signifies acceptance of ARBA and Texas RBA show rules.
3. The Texas RBA, nor the show site facility will be responsible in case of fire, theft, accidents, or vandalism. Every precaution will be taken to prevent fire, theft, vandalism, and accidents from occurring.
4. Any exhibitor in good standing of the ARBA & Texas RBA will be allowed to enter the show. It is NOT required that a person be an ARBA or Texas RBA member to enter.
5. Show age groups are by ARBA requirements. Ages 5-19 are classified as Youth (but may enter Open if they so choose instead of exhibiting as a youth) and ages 0-4 and 19+ are categorized as Open exhibitors.
6. Any animal showing signs of disease or illness will be prompted to leave the building immediately. **If your animal is disqualified for illness, it will be scratched from all subsequent shows without refund of show fees.**
7. Disrespect shown toward judges, show officials, or support staff will result in disqualification and a request to leave the event without reimbursement. Non-sportsmanlike behavior will result in being asked to depart, entries will be scratched, and fees forfeited.
8. Show officials reserve the right to refuse entry for any exhibitor.
9. Parents/Guardians must supervise all youth under the age of 18. Children are not allowed to run in the building at any time.
10. Each class will only be announced 3 times. After the third time, the rabbits on the table will be judged accordingly and the missing rabbits will be scratched without reimbursement. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to pay attention to the show and ensure their animals are presented at the appropriate times.
11. Awards must be claimed while still at the show. If an exhibitor desires to have awards mailed, they must make arrangements prior to the end of the show and are responsible for all shipping fees.

12. Entry fees are charged according to the advertised fee schedule. Adjustments to fees will only occur in the case of an error made by show staff. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to ensure that entries are received by the show secretary prior to fee change cutoff times/dates. Entry to the show is an agreement to pay associated fees – **including if cancellation occurs without notification of the host club.**

13. All animals must be contained in leak-proof, solid-based carriers.

14. Feces and animal bedding cannot at any time be dumped in the indoor trash containers outside of the show room. Exhibitors may ask for a garbage can liner so they may tend their animals and dispose of the waste in outdoor dumping areas or in the showroom provided containers.

15. Exhibitors must keep their area clean and orderly while occupying the building during the show and when leaving. Please be cognizant of fire safety and escape pathways.

16. Exhibitors may not enter the same rabbit in both open and youth for the same show. If an exhibitor desires to change divisions, the changes must be complete prior to posted check-in deadlines.

17. Any issue that arises during the event will first be resolved by the immediate chair of that area. The show Superintendent will have full discretion if the conflict cannot be resolved by the chair of that portion of our program.

18. If you wish to file a formal complaint with Texas RBA, you may do so. The complaint forms are available at the show Superintendent table. A fee will be charged in the instance of a protest regarding judging procedures as per ARBA policy.

19. No changes or substitutions can be made at the show table. Both must be completed at the secretary's table prior to the entry deadline. A verification slip will be given to the exhibitor by the secretary if there is a problem requiring a change during the show; changes at the table will not be permitted without this slip for any reason.

20. No other club or persons of another club may sell items or hold fundraisers without prior permission from the show committee. Exhibitors can sell rabbits within the showroom without permission from the show committee. We do ask that rabbits for sale be advertised as their true quality – pet, brood, or show, with show being without any disqualifications and within acceptable condition for show standards. Again, no ill animals may be present in the building.

21. Texas RBA will accept cash, credit/debit cards, and money orders for changes/late entries at the show. If paying with a check, the return check policy will apply. Individuals choosing to use the credit/debit card option will be charged a **4.5% fee** that will cover the costs associated with offering this service.

22. NO tobacco products in any part of the show building. Outside smoking must be 25 feet from any entrance.

CATALOGS

SECTION 15.A show catalog must be furnished to any person upon request. The show catalog must be furnished to all hired judges and registrars at least 14 days prior to the show date. The show catalog must contain the club name, show date, show location, entry deadline, time judging will start, the name and address of the show secretary and show superintendent, and any required specialty club information. The catalog should supply as much information as possible and must be available at least 14 days prior to the show date.

The following must be printed in the show catalog:

(A) Open Sanctioned Show – OFFICIAL ARBA SANCTIONED SHOW, ARBA Executive Director, PO Box 400, Knox, PA 16232-0400. ARBA website: www.arba.net. Membership Dues: \$20.00 per yr., 3 yrs. \$50.00. Combination Husband & Wife: \$30.00 per yr., 3 yrs. \$75.00.

(B) Youth Sanctioned Show – OFFICIAL ARBA YOUTH SANCTIONED SHOW, ARBA Executive Director, PO Box 400, Knox, PA 16232-0400. ARBA website: www.arba.net. Membership Dues: \$12.00 per yr., 3 yrs. \$30.00.

(C) Announcement of the date and place of the next ARBA Convention and Annual Meeting.

(D) 1- Action taken by the ARBA Board will be evaluated on a case-by-case basis depending on the circumstances noted and in accordance with the ARBA Constitution and By-Laws

2– Please note the following recommendations:

- a) Exhibitors should follow ARBA recommended biosecurity guidelines.**
- b) Exhibitors and show officials should wash the undercarriage and tires of all vehicles and trailers before going to and after departing a show.**
- c) Exhibitors residing in a state with a confirmed case of RHDV in the past 30 days should have a health certificate (CVI) issued within fourteen (14) days of the show.**
- d) Use an appropriate disinfectant that will inactivate RHDV.**
- e) The ARBA club show committee has the right to refuse any entry for due cause.**
- f) The ARBA recommends carrying cages be cleaned prior to going to a show. The ARBA recommends the following products: kitty litter, newspaper, puppy pads, or other inert products used for bedding.**
- g) State and county officials may impose additional stricter sanctions / requirements.**
- h) Show officials can designate additional requirements to attend an ARBA sanctioned show.**
- i) If you are not comfortable with the provisions in 15.(D), please continue to maintain biosecurity at your residence.**
