ABOUT WRCS

Wanderlust Rabbit & Cavy Shows was chartered in 2021, holding our first show a few months later in November 2021 with a show aptly themed "Down The Rabbit Hole". Our inaugural show was the largest local show to be held in the State of Oregon, boasting a 15 judge lineup. Since that very first show, we became dedicated to providing the exhibitors in the Pacific Northwest with high quality shows in unique locations. In February 2023 we broke our original show entry record, which only further showed that we are ready for bigger shows! Our main goals in starting this club were to promote opportunities for breed specialty shows, encourage more youth shows and involvement, and better serve the cavy side of our hobby. Our exhibitors and constituent clubs are truly what make the shows put on by the WRCS show group so unique and special. We are thrilled to put on our first regional show and to have you all along for the ride!

LOCATION

Clark County Event Center

South Halls 1 & 2 - 17200 NE Delfel Rd, Ridgefield, WA 98642

Located in the Northern Portland Metropolitan Area, it is located just north of the city of Vancouver, WA, about 25 minutes from Portland, OR and the Portland International Airport.

The building the show will be held in is about 32,000 square feet, and has solid concrete flooring, large roll-up doors with direct access to the parking lot for easy loading/unloading into the building.

SHOWS OFFERED

WRCS will hold a single open/youth rabbit show Saturday, and double open/youth rabbit and cavy shows Sunday.

Dear Breed Specialty and National Clubs:

Thank you so much for your consideration in hosting your show with Wanderlust Rabbit & Cavy Shows in scenic Ridgefield, WA! Located on the north bank of the Columbia River, in the shadow of the infamous Mt. St. Helens, Ridgefield is located on north side of Vancouver, WA within the Portland Metro Area. Interstate 5 which passes on the east side of the grounds serves as the main artery route in the area, with about 25 minute travel time from Downtown Portland and less than that to Portland International Airport (PDX).

Included are all the details regarding the Cascade Spring Summit show.

Below are the options in which you can choose to hold your specialty and/or national shows with us:

1. Let us take care of it all!

WRCS hires, contracts, and pays the expenses for your judge of choice. Included usage of the facility, judging equipment, caged cooping, set-up and tear down of equipment, shavings, and use of WRCS show secretary services (with remark cards) is also covered.

\$9.00/head judged

2. Perfect for specialty shows

Use of a WRCS judge (you select from our hired list). Use of facility, judging equipment is also covered. Use of a WRCS show secretary is optional (see below*)

\$2.00/head judged

3. All you need is the equipment and building

Use of facility judging equipment are covered. **You privately hire and pay your own judge** not on the WRCS lineup. Use of a WRCS show secretary is optional (see below*)

\$1.00/head judged

*If you select options #1, #2, or #3, you may use WRCS show secretary services at no extra cost entered without remark cards OR \$0.25/head with remark cards. The show secretary will collect and process entries, print and sort control sheets and take the entry fees during regular check-in at the show. Post-show the show secretary will furnish exhibitor reports, legs, and submit the breed specialty report with the national specialty club, and file the official show report with the ARBA. The expenses incurred from your specialty show will be deducted from the payback of profits to your club. If you use your own show secretary, you must follow the entry rules and deadlines set by WRCS.

Additional Specialty Shows

Additional specialty shows to a cooped national (see #1 on Page 2) are formatted like option #2. If you do an additional specialty show to your cooped national show, you will not be charged again for the cooping rate like in option #1 because the cooping expense has already been covered.

Cooping

Cooping is only included in option #1. Cooping is required by the National Clubs of many breeds (Mini Rex, Satin, etc), but consider not having coops for breeds that don't require them. You can find out if cooping is required by checking the Constitution & By-Laws or Specialty Show Rules of your club. If you don't need coops, it would be a lot less intensive and costly for your club. You may also select to have cooping as an additional option for exhibitors.

Judges

If your club is hosting a cooped national with us, and you have to select judges in order to present your bid, we will hire and contract the judge for your national show. If you are holding a non-cooped specialty or National show and wish to not use a judge on our lineup, you will be responsible for hosting, lodging, travel, and any other expenses for your judge.

Booth Space

WRCS will provide 10'x10' booth space for the Breed Club of any National Show, regardless of which option you choose. Booth space for vendors, clubs not associated with a national show, etc will have to book a space at our regular booth space rate.

Hotel

WRCS is working on finding a host hotel in close proximity to the Clark County Event Center. Once one has been secured the information will be forwarded.

Sanctions

All specialty clubs are responsible for requesting their own ARBA Sanctions and once the WRCS Show Secretary receive the sanction numbers, they will forward it to your show superintendent/club contact to request national breed sanctions. Upon submission of your request to hold a national/specialty show with us, the respective WRCS Show Secretary's information that is required to submit a request for sanctions will be supplied.

Awards

Your club is responsible for all awards for your shows.
