SHOW RULES (your entry indicates agreement to ARBA and show rules)

1. Show will be governed by the latest ARBA show rules, entering indicates agreement to these rules & the other rules listed below. A full list of ARBA rules can be found at <https://arba.net/official-arba-show-rules/>
2. The Iowa State Rabbit Breeders Association, Inc. (ISRBA) will not be responsible for accidents; including but not limited to: loss in case of fire, human or animal illness, theft or providential destruction. However, every precaution will be taken to prevent the same. We will follow the current state guidelines for COVID-19.
3. A good check, PayPal, US money order, or cash must accompany your entry to be accepted. There will be a \$35.00 service fee charge on all returned checks. Any legs/points will be forfeited until the issue is resolved. Make all checks payable to the Iowa State Rabbit Breeders Association (ISRBA).
4. The ISRBA reserves the right to refuse entry/entries from any party, or at any time to remove such person or persons disrupting the show or causing problems. Said parties' entries will be scratched without refund. All entries are final, no refunds will be given.
5. The ISRBA reserves the right to substitute, add, or remove judges as deemed necessary.
6. ALL animals entered must be permanently & legibly tattooed in the left ear. Rabbits not legibly tattooed will be disqualified at the judge's discretion.
7. Youth may enter in both open & youth shows with different animals, but the same rabbit/cavy cannot be entered in both open & youth for the same show.
8. Youth MUST place youth rabbits on the show tables (18 years & under).
9. Any/all animals exhibiting signs of sickness will be removed from the showroom. **Keep sick animals home! ISRBA will refuse entries from exhibitors according to the ARBA recommendations for RHDV2 on the day of the show.**
10. ISRBA is not responsible for any donated awards. To have the breed sanctioned next year, there must be 10 shown in the breed. **AWARDS WILL NOT BE MAILED.**
11. Parents and/or guardians will be held responsible for their own actions as well as those of their children and/or those children that accompanied them.
12. No smoking or vaping in the building, no alcoholic beverages are allowed anywhere on the fairgrounds, please abide as you will be responsible for any fees administered by the venue if there is a violation.
13. NO DOGS other than ADA Service Dogs will be allowed in the showroom. We will follow all rules set forth in the ADA. www.ada.gov/regs2010/service_animal_qa.html
14. All carriers must have solid bottoms and stack carriers when requested. Grooming tables & chairs should not block exhibitor pathways, the aisles need to remain open.
15. Exhibitors will be responsible for getting their rabbits to the judging tables as soon as the class is called. **Rabbits will be called no more than three (3) times**; if not on the table after the final call the judge will continue. There will be no re-judging of a class due to missing rabbits. Each table will have breeds listed under the judge's name. If you think you may need some assistance (i.e. multiple breeds on the table at the same time), please ask another exhibitor or let show officials know & we will try to find you a helper.
16. Please groom all wool breeds outside of the buildings.
17. Any sanctions that have been sponsored after the printing of this show flyer will be posted at the secretary's table.
18. Only show officials, judges, judges or registrars in training, or writing volunteers are allowed behind show tables.
19. Please be respectful to other exhibitors & to show officials by keeping walkways clear of debris, chairs, carriers, & show tables. **Please clean up after yourselves.** Keep your area clean during the show & clean up before you leave; **do not leave your mess for others to clean, that's not how you want to be remember**

(D) 1- Action taken by the ARBA Board will be evaluated on a case-by-case basis depending on the circumstances noted and in accordance with the ARBA Constitution and By-Laws2– Please note the following recommendations:a) Exhibitors should follow ARBA recommended biosecurity guidelines.b) Exhibitors and show officials should wash the undercarriage and tires of all vehicles and trailers before going to and after departing a show. c) Exhibitors residing in a state with a confirmed case of RHDV in the past 30 days should have a health certificate (CVI) issued within fourteen (14) days of the show.d) Use an appropriate disinfectant that will inactivate RHDV.e) The ARBA club show committee has the right to refuse any entry for due cause.f) The ARBA recommends carrying cages be cleaned prior to going to a show. The ARBA recommends the following products: kitty litter, newspaper, puppy pads, or other inert products used for bedding.g) State and county officials may impose additional stricter sanctions / requirements.h) Show officials can designate additional requirements to attend an ARBA sanctioned show.i) If you are not comfortable with the provisions in 15.(D), please continue to maintain biosecurity at your residence.
