From the North—Watertown Area

Take I-81 South into Syracuse to Exit 22. Follow Bear Street (Route 298) to I-690 West.

From the South—Binghamton/Cortland Area

Take I-81 North into Syracuse, then follow I-690 West.

From the New York City/Downstate Area

Take best route to Binghamton, NY, then take I-81 North into Syracuse to I-690 West.

SHOW RULES

- 1. All animals are entered and shown at the risk of the owner. NYR&CBA will not be responsible in case of fire, theft, accident or providential destruction. However, every precaution will be taken to eliminate danger.
- 2. NYR&CBA reserves the right to substitute a judge or judges at any time it deems necessary.
- 3. All entries must have a legible permanent tattoo in the left ear.
- 4. Exhibitors must check-in with the show secretary prior to the start of the show. There will be no printed check-in sheets at check-in. Exhibitors are responsible for reviewing the email confirmation sent via email from the show secretary PRIOR to check-in.
- 5. Scratches will be done at the judge's tables. No refunds given for scratched entries.
- 6. No changes can be made at the judge's table unless approved by the show secretary FIRST.
- 7. Any animal showing signs of sickness or disease will be immediately removed from the showroom, and entry fees will not be refunded.
- 8. Entries must be submitted via the post or through email. NO telephone entries will be accepted.
- 9. This is a carrying case show. NO express shipments will be accepted. All carrying cages MUST have leak proof bottoms. ANY cage found leaking will be removed from the show room. There is NO cooping available for this show.
- 10. Absolutely NO breeding of stock in the show room.
- 11. Absolutely **NO Cats, Birds or Dogs allowed** in the show room, except for registered & leashed service animals with certified paperwork provided.
- 12.All exhibitors are responsible for getting their animals to the show table promptly. There will be NO more than three (3) calls for a class. After that, any animal not on the table will be marked as no show.
- 13. Payment for entry fees must be made PRIOR to the start of the show, and will mean that the exhibitor agrees to comply with all A.R.B.A. rules and those rules set forth in this catalog.
- 14. Judging starts promptly at times listed in this catalog. Please be on time.
- 15. Anyone causing a disruption or attempting to intimidate a judge will immediately be asked to leave the show and will forfeit all show fees.
- 16. There must be 10 or more animals shown in a Sanctioned breed to be eligible for an award.
- 17.ALL PRIZES must be picked up before leaving the show.
- 18. CHILDREN MUST BE UNDER PARENTAL CONTROL AT ALL TIMES, otherwise both will be asked to leave the show and entry money will be forfeited.
- 19. For safety reasons, NO wheeled toys/equipment, such as bicycles, skateboards, Razor scooters, etc. are allowed in the showroom except for wheeled assistance for handicapped exhibitors.
