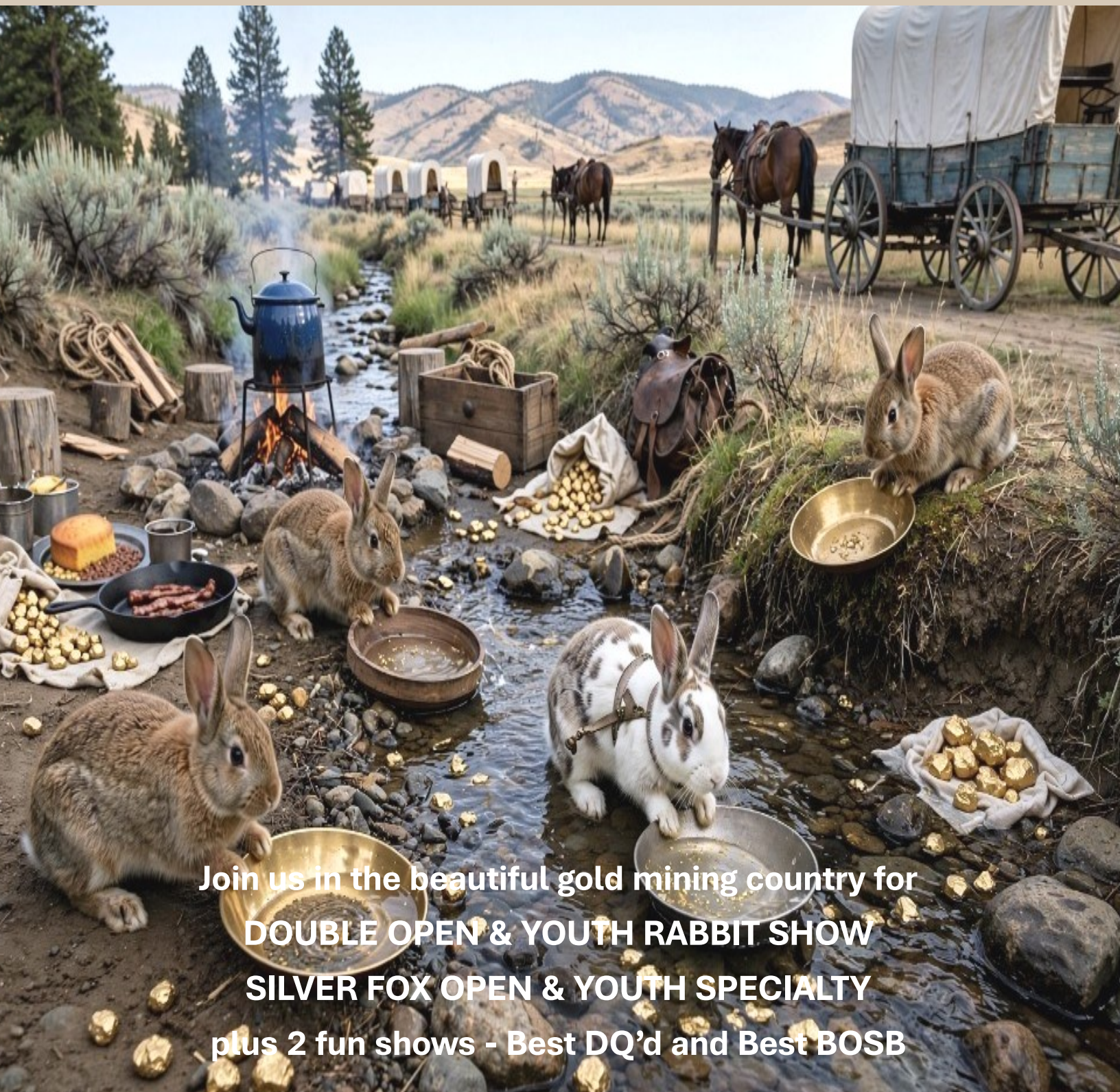

From Sacramento area: Interstate 80 East to Exit 135 (174 West to Colfax), right on 174 S Canyon Way, right on 174 S Auburn Street, Left on Grassvalley Street, Right on Main Street. Left on School Street. Sierra Vista Center will be on the right. GPS or mapping system directions appear to be correct.

There is parking on the streets around the center. However, please note that residential homes share the streets. Please do not block driveways or park on street corners.



UNLOADING, PARKING, & LOADING

Due to the limited parking and location of the center please be aware that there is a small unloading and loading area above the lower level parking lot. Enter the lower level parking lot off of School St (**blue arrow**) drive up to the unloading area which is in the back (**red arrow**) and then after unloading please move your vehicle down to the lower level so that others can unload. You can also park on the side streets for easier access (**yellow lines**).

We apologize in advance for any inconvenience this may create.

We will have volunteers out at the unloading and loading area. They will be wearing orange or yellow safety vests. If you need assistance, please locate a show volunteer. We asked that you follow the volunteers direction when unloading your vehicle and move your vehicle to the lower level lot when done so other exhibitors can unload. The judging will take place in the gym, which is seen in the photo as the large white building with the capitol image above it, not the building with the red triangle marker. We ask that you please set up rabbit cages/tables/stands in single line rows leaving room in-between isles and around the judging tables for ease of access for exhibitors needing to place their rabbits on the show tables.

Judging starts promptly at 8:30am

A judging schedule will be posted at each judge's table and the secretary's table. Each exhibitor is responsible to carry their rabbits to the judging table at the proper time. Posted schedules are subject to change. Be sure to watch carefully and listen for announcements so that you do not miss your class. **Show B classes may be judged before that same breed is judged for Show A.** *Entry fees are non-refundable and classes will not be judged over.*

If you sanction with your breed club on your own, please make sure that you notify the show secretary Abigail Alerton so that the necessary show reports can be forwarded to the proper club.

OFFICIAL RULES

This is an official ARBA sanctioned show and will be governed by the latest revised rules of ARBA. .2

- Filing an entry *implies acceptance* of these rules.
- This show will be a one day carry cage double open and youth rabbit show.
- All rabbits must be permanently marked in the left ear prior to showing. A licensed ARBA Registrar will be available for ear tattoo's as well as ARBA registrations. All rabbits must have a left ear tattoo.
- Exhibitors are responsible for making sure their rabbits are taken to the judging area when called.
- Absolutely no refund of entry fees will be made.
- Any animal DQ'd in show A for illness (snot, pink eye, etc) or disease (ear canker, etc) is automatically withdrawn from Show B.
- Please check your exhibits before entering.
- Awards must be picked up the day of the show. Legs are emailed within 30 days.
- All animals must be healthy and in proper size transport cages.
- All animals are entered at the owner's risk. Every effort is made to safeguard the animals and to minimize hazards and risks.
- The community center, club, judges or show staff are not liable for death or injury to any animal. Parents – children must be under supervision of an adult at all times.
- Exhibitors must clean their area when leaving.
- Once entry is made the entry fee is due. Even if you are unable to attend, the funds must be paid. Failure to pay the fees will ban your entry from all MRCA shows until settled. *All fur entries will be considered breed fur. Fur entries are \$2.00 per Show.
- Any issues arising that cannot be resolved by reference to the above rules shall be decided by the official show Committee and the decision will be final.
- Rabbit show entries must be postmarked by Wednesday, September 9th, 2026. Email entries must be received by 11:59pm Saturday, September 12th, 2026.
- Entry fee per rabbit = \$8.00 (Single or Double show) and \$4.00 (specialty, if offered). If you are entering for Silver Fox specialty, please pay the \$4.00/per rabbit specialty fee to the SF specialty show secretary.
- Entry fee for fun show for Best of DQ'd and Best of BOSB is \$2.00 and paid day of show.

NO ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED BY PHONE

If entering by email, type the class information **IN** the body of the email. Do Not send attachments. Please indicate if youth or open entry.

- * For more information regarding entries and payments, please see secretary information on page 2 of this catalog. Double Open/Youth show entries and Silver Fox Specialty entries are sent to different secretaries. Silver Fox entry fee's are also paid separately from double open/youth shows.
- * Ear # changes can be done at the table but must be done before judging begins. No other changes are allowed. Exhibitors must have ear # changes completed by superintendent or person doing control sheet.
- * Judging begins promptly at 8:30am. Doors will open at 7:00am on the morning of the show. Please note that there will be NO building access the evening before the show.
- * PLEASE unload your rabbits and equipment in the unloading zone and then move your vehicle to the lower level or street parking. DO NOT PARK IN THE UNLOADING AREA!
- * NO dogs allowed into the showroom other than service dogs.
