SHOW RULES:

1. This show will be conforming to all ARBA show rules.
2. There will be no alcoholic beverages allowed at the show ground.
3. Parents, you are responsible for your children. Please keep an eye on their whereabouts and activities. Parents will be liable for damage.
4. No breeding of rabbits in the showroom.
5. CPaRBA, Tri-CoRCoPa, Raystown Rabbit Ranchers will not be responsible in case of fire, theft, or providential loss.
6. Showroom opens at 7:00am
7. All changes in your entry must be made by 8:30am for the first show.
8. All stock must be in showroom by 8:00am judging starts at 9:00am
9. Any animals showing signs of disease will be removed from the showroom and entry fee forfeited.
10. This is a carry cage show. Carriers must have a leak-proof bottom.
11. Judging will be done by private ear number. All animals must have permanent and legible earmarks according to the ARBA rules.
12. Any exhibitor attempting to or interfering with, annoying, influencing or charging the show in order of breeds to be judged by a judge will be ejected and barred from the show with their entry fee forfeited.

Only the Show Superintendent can make changes to the order of and the breed that the judge for the show.

13. There will be no changes made to the paperwork at the judging table without the consent of the show secretary.
14. Any additional rules will be posted in the showroom.
15. CParBA, Tri-CoRCoPa, Raystown Rabbit Ranchers are not responsible for any animals left in the showroom overnight on Saturday September 26, 2026
16. CParBA, Tri-CoRCoPa, Raystown Rabbit Ranchers and Judges will not be liable for injury to any rabbit.
17. Any returned checks will have a \$25.00 service charge, and the exhibitor will have their name removed from all show reports. We will not expect any entries for any of our shows until the check has been reconciled.
18. Awards will be given out for BOB and BOS sanctioned breeds listed open providing there are 10 or more animals shown in the breed.
19. Awards will be provided for BIS, 1st RIS and 2nd RIS in open and youth.
20. All awards must be picked on the day of the show. No awards will be mailed.
21. Breeds with less than 10 rabbits will not be sanctioned for the next show unless sponsored.
22. The ARBA host club has reserved the right to refuse entries from all locations within 150 miles, which has had a confirmed outbreak of RCD/RHD/VHD within the past 60days of the entry deadline.
23. Youth exhibitors do not have to carry their own animals to the show table, but a youth must put them on the table.

Novice: 6 jumps 2-3 rails 4-6 inches (limited to teams who have never tried hopping before)

Beginner: 8 jumps 3-5 rails 6-10 inches 1 spread jump

Intermediate: 10 jumps 5-7 rails 10-14 inches. 2 spread jumps

Advanced: 10 jumps 7-9 rails 14-18 inches 2 spread jumps

Club will have harnesses and leashes available to borrow and possibly some for sale

Disclaimer: The jumps are homemade and although they are close they may not be precise in measurements.

Jump at your own risk. Club not responsible for injuries to rabbit or handler.

Rules:

- exhibitors must wear closed toe secure footwear with rubber soles. Sneakers preferred but absolutely NO sandals or cowboy boots.
- Only approved H-style harnesses are allowed. The H-style harness must have detachments from the neck strap and girth strap and the D-ring must be in the back to ensure the least pressure on the rabbit's neck. No vests, collars, figure 8 harnesses nor harnesses with the metal part at the rabbit's throat area are allowed in the competition.
- Leashes must be a minimum of 4 feet with a snap hook. The leash is to be made from soft flat material no less than 3/8" inch wide. Retractable and elastic leashes are prohibited. Rabbit's leashes must be securely attached at the girth straps of their harnesses and may only be used to carefully retrieve and guide rabbits. Leashes should hang loose whenever rabbits jump.
- Absolutely no mishandling of the rabbit allowed. The judge can DQ a handler for rough handling including but not limited to staging rabbit by lead, like dying rabbit by lead, using foot to move rabbit ect.
- The team will get 3 runs. Team will choose a direction. Team can also chose to forgo any runs
- 3 minute limit per run attempt. If a team exceeds the 3min time they will be stopped and given a DNF
- The fastest run with the least amount of faults is the score kept
- Fastest team with the least faults wins the class.

Faults:

- a) Knocking down of a rail or entire jump by rabbit or handler is 1 fault regardless of the number of rails knocked down.
- b) Hopping around the jump, so that the lateral supports of a spread jump are passed. c) Knock down an earlier jump or wrong jump by the handler or rabbit.
- d) Lifting a rabbit over a jump with all rails on.
- e) The rabbit is lifted by its lead over a jump. First time a warning is given. Second time results in DNF from all subsequent runs and disqualification from the class.

Agility:

Same rules and faults as above.

Course will include a combination of jumps according to the Beginner and intermediate levels as well as some or all the following apparatuses

A-frame: The rabbit must stay on the surface of the A-Frame, ascending the ramp, crossing the apex, and descending the ramp in the direction indicated by the judge. The obstacle shall be considered complete if the rabbit ascends the A Frame to the top of the apex and the front feet touch the down side of the A Frame, then the rabbit proceeds to the floor, ground, car pet, or mat at the end of the A Frame

Bridge. The rabbit must stay on the surface of the bridge, ascending the ramp in the direction indicated by the judge, crossing the cross plank, and descending the other ramp. The obstacle shall be considered complete if the rabbit ascends the Bridge to the top, crosses over the flat upper section, and the front feet touch the down side of the Bridge, then the rabbit proceeds to the floor, ground, carpet, or mat at the end of the Bridge.

Hoop: go through the hoop without knocking it down. Handler will pass leash from 1 hand to the other through the hoop

Teeter-totter: The rabbit must stay on the surface of the teeter's plank while ascending, cross the plank's pivot point, causing the teeter to tilt to the ground on the other end before descending the remainder of the plank. The plank must touch the ground prior to the rabbit leaving the plank.

Tunnel: The rabbit enters the tunnel in the direction indicated by the course, and exits the tunnel at the opposite end.

Pause box: The rabbit must stay on or within the pause box for 5 seconds. If the rabbit exits the pause box before 5 seconds the obstacle is considered not complete.
