Payment will take place upon checking in at the show. Entries are \$4.00 per animal and \$2.00 per fur entry.

# Show Rules

## General

1. This show will conform to all [ARBA show rules](#).
2. There will be no alcoholic beverages allowed at the showgrounds.
3. All children are solely the responsibility of the guardian in attendance.
4. No pets other than service animals as permitted by the ADA.
5. Smoking in the show room or within 15 feet of an entrance to the show room is prohibited, including the use of vape/e-cig devices.
6. Exhibitors will be responsible for any damages they cause to the show facilities.
7. Chairs and grooming tables in designated areas only and only as space permits.
8. Carriers must have a leak proof bottom.
9. A registrar will be available to register your rabbits/cavies.
10. All attendees are required to comply with facility rules, SRCBA show rules, ARBA show rules, and local laws and regulations. All decisions and interpretations of the show committee are final and binding and are made in the best interest of the attendees and overall event. Show officials will be treated with respect both at the show and on social media. Failure to comply may result in removal from the show room, disqualification of entry, and forfeiture of any entry fee paid.
- 11. Any animal presented with disease will be removed from the showroom promptly**

# Show Rules

## Show

1. All exhibitors must be checked in by the designated time in the show catalog.
2. No remark cards will be used.
3. No changes may be made at the table, including tattoo number, without the approval of the show secretary.
4. Please review the schedule for entering rabbits online. Exhibitors are solely responsible for getting entries in at the designated time. No exceptions will be made for those who try to enter and the deadline passes during the process.
5. No changes to entries, other than tattoo number, will be made after the entry deadline.
6. Rabbit and all cavy judging will begin promptly at 9:00 AM on Saturday, except for any specialty shows beginning at 8:00 AM.
7. The show committee will announce the respective breeds being judged one time. There will be only one additional call made for any missing rabbits in the breed with a 90 second wait time before the judge will be instructed to move on. Please listen.
8. Exhibitors of a breed are responsible for finding a writer for their breed. If writers are not found we will go on to the next breed.
9. SRCBA may change showing order and judges at any time during the show.
10. This show will be sanctioned with ARBA and all published breed specialty clubs.
11. SRCBA reserves the right to make changes to the show at any time as deemed necessary by the Show Superintendent or Show Committee.
12. No ribbons for class placings will be available for open rabbits. Ribbons for youth, sanctioned breeds only will be provided. Awards will be provided for sanctioned breeds for Best of Breed and Best Opposite of Breed.
13. All animals entered in the youth competitions must be presented to the table by a youth exhibitor. No adult may exhibit for the youth.

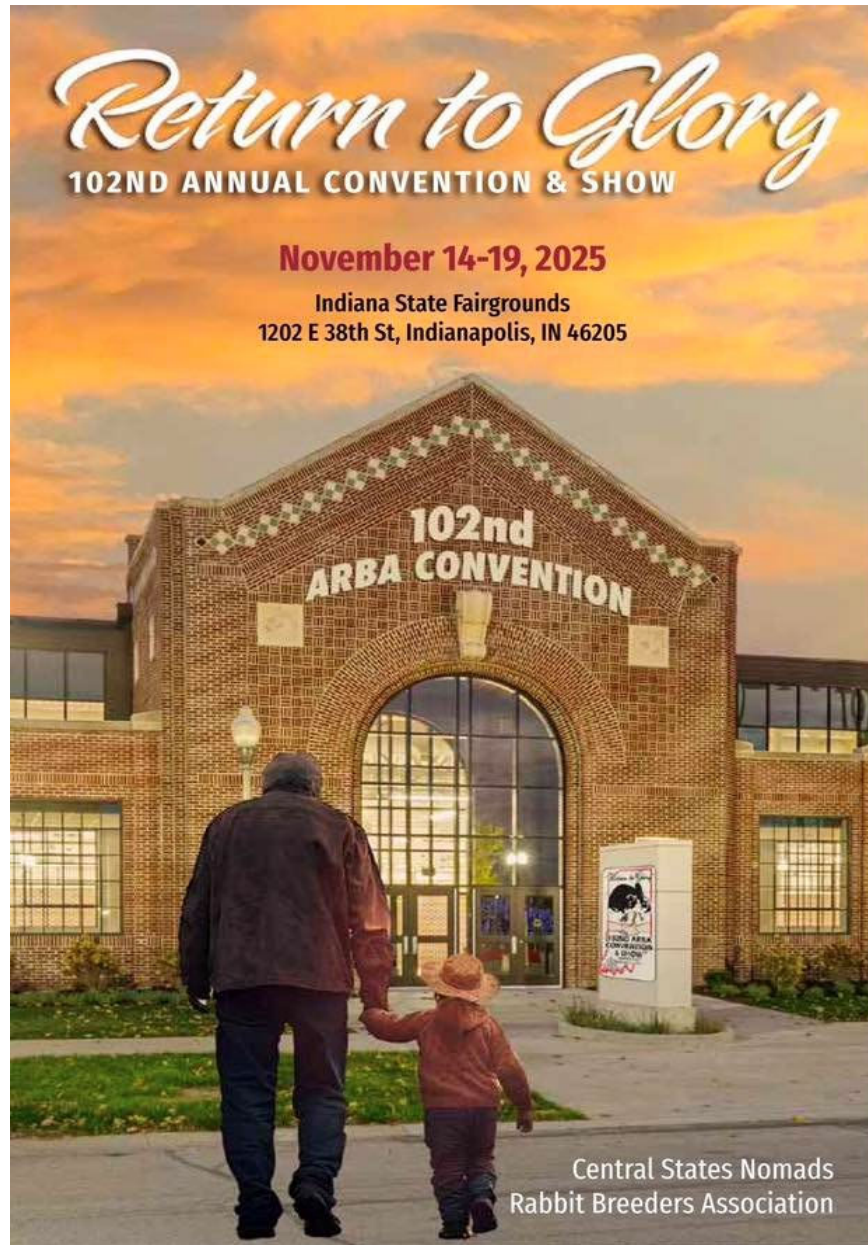


# Show Rules

## Entries

1. Youth may enter a specific rabbit in open OR youth, but not in both for the same show.
2. Make checks payable to SRCBA.
3. Post-dated checks will not be accepted.
4. Returned checks will be processed and submitted by SRCBA's bank resubmission services at the expense of the exhibitor (bank will automatically charge the exhibitor's account the state regulated NSF collections fees for each attempted re-submission). SRCBA will also charge a \$50 administrative fee to the exhibitor. The exhibitor has 10 days upon notice to make good on the bad check and associated fees (only certified bank check or money order will be accepted). If the exhibitor fails to make good within 10 days including associated fees, the exhibitor will be removed from all show reports and eliminated from the show (cannot be reversed once removed). An additional monthly charge of \$5 will be assessed until the exhibitor has fully resolved the issue. Unresolved issues will be prosecuted.
5. SRCBA reserves the right to invoice an exhibitor and refuse entry to future shows if exhibitor makes an entry and does not attend the show or scratch their entry ahead of the entry deadline.
6. Payment will be collected during check-in of the show.
7. Exhibitors have until the entry deadline to remove any scratches from their entry. After that time scratches will be charged at check-in like a normal entry.
8. SRCBA will strictly enforce the denial of any entry from within 100 miles of a deemed RHVD Zone. This includes any spectators, judges, or exhibitors. Any known person to bring in an animal for transport from the infected radius will be banned from all SRCBA current and future shows.

# Silent Auction

Please consider a quality donation to our silent auction for rabbits and cavy's. All proceeds are split 50/50 with the donor and club, and club proceeds benefit our youth members through scholarships and other initiatives.

1. Starting bid for all animals is \$20, no other reserves will be placed.
2. Animal must be an ARBA recognized breed/variety and meet all requirements for ARBA registration. High quality animals that no longer meet registration requirements may be included **at the discretion of the show committee**, including brood animals that may be over weight.
3. Animals not meeting basic breed characteristics and standards will be declined from the silent auction. Must be free of disqualifications, unless as listed above and at the discretion of the show committee, and communicable disease. Complete, three generations pedigree must be included with animal at time of donation.
4. SRCBA reserves the right to refuse a donation for any reason.
5. Donor should provide transition feed in an appropriate amount for the animal donated.
6. Donor share of sale must be picked up within one hour of the conclusion of the auction or it may be considered forfeit to the club.
7. For any donation that does not sell, the donor must pick the animal up no later than one hour past the conclusion of the auction, or it will be considered forfeit and property of the SRCBA.
8. All sales are considered final at the close of the auction.
9. The decision of any SRCBA member working the auction is considered final.
10. SRCBA reserves the right to make modifications and exceptions to any of the previous rules.

# Hotels and Lodging

Numerous local hotels are available close to the show room, particularly on Leffel Lane (Exit 54 off I-70) and First St/Bechtel Ave area (take the OH-41 exit from US-68).
